CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. The next matter on our calendar is, we have another proposed rulemaking and that is actually scheduled for 11:00 a.m. It is approximately eleven -- oh I'm sorry, it's eleven -- all right. I'm sorry. Okay, so, it is -- I am - all right. I'm in a different time zone, so I'm somewhat confused.

(Laughter.)

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right, so, we are -- our next hearing is scheduled for 11:00 a.m. and it is 11:22.

(Laughter.)

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right, so,
I apologize for that. I thought we were - all
right, all right.

So let me -- so our next rulemaking is -- it is Notice of Proposed Rulemaking, the Technical Amendment of 2020.

Good morning again. This is second of two rulemaking hearings the Board will hold today, in accordance with D.C. Official Code Section 25-2 (audio interference).

The Board is conducting a public hearing and taking comment on the technical amendment rulemaking that makes several amendments to Title 23 of the District of Columbia Municipal Regulations, DCMR.

These proposed amendments make several changes to a number of chapters within Title 23, to conform to those corollary changes contained in the Alcohol and Beverage Control Board License Categories: Endorsements and Hourly and Percentage Rate Amendment Act of 2019; number two, Manufacturer and Pub Permit (audio interference) Amendment Act of 2019; number three, the Alcohol and Beverage Procedural and Technical Amendment Act of 2019; and number four, Alcoholic Beverage Enforcement Amendment Act of 2019.

Additionally, this hearing makes other administrative changes not related to the act.

This proposed rulemaking was adopted by the Board on June 24th, 2020 on a seven to zero vote. It was published in the D.C. Register on August 21st, 2020 at 67 DCR 95 -- 9975. The 30 comment period ended on September 21st, 2020.

I will begin this hearing by calling

on those witnesses who notified the agency in advance regarding their desire to address the Board.

The Board will then entertain comments from other interested parties who did not register in advance, but who wish to be heard.

If you have prepared written remarks, please email them to abra.legal@dc.gov and we will ensure that they are properly filed with the Board's official records.

It is my understanding that we -- we don't have any witnesses who have informed the Board that they wanted to testify publicly on this matter. So, since we do not have any witnesses who have identified themselves, I will once again ask Ms. Andrews to see if there is anyone participating on the call remotely to identify themself publicly and make any statements, if they so desire.

(Pause.)

MS. ANDREWS: Mr. Chair, there is no one that wants to comment.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Thank you. So, because there is no one who wants to comment, there is still an opportunity for the public to

participate by submitting their comments and if 1 2 we receive any comments, the Board will take 3 those matters under advisement and move forward. All right, I think we have -- so, 4 therefore I will close the hearing formally and 5 I'll wait to see if there is any comments. 6 7 If there are comments the Board will 8 take them on advisement. If not, we will 9 finalize the rulemaking. I believe that we have come to the end 10 11 of our agenda items. We have -- we have done our 12 calendar and I have read all of the -- all our 13 agenda items and so, if there -- if no other 14 comments by any Board members, I will close the 15 meeting. 16 Any comments or concerns by the Board 17 members, prior to me closing the meeting --18 adjourning for the day? 19 Hearing none, then, all right. 20 (Pause.) 21 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right, as 22 Chairperson of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board for the District of Columbia, in accordance 23 24 with Title 3, Chapter 405, Office of Open 25 Government, I move that ABC Board hold a closed
