License Number 95169. 5 Good morning, Mr. Orellana, can you 6 7 please elevate the rights of the licensee and the 8 government in this case, please? 9 MR. ORELLANA: Good morning. The primary witness and 18 co-owner is actually out of the country and not expected to be back until October 28. 19 20 And so we were asking to have the show 21 cause hearing be rescheduled because not only is 2.2 she the co-owner, but she's also the primary 23 witness. She was there on the date of this 2.4 incident. 25 Counsel nor I anticipate that we will

1 other thing I just want to advise both parties. 2 If this matter goes to a hearing, seven days before the hearing both parties are required to 3 exchange documents and witnesses. 4 5 Failure by either side to provide, to 6 exchange documents and witnesses seven days 7 before the hearing, the Board is empowered to 8 prevent that side from moving forward, unless 9 reasonable cause is shown. Any questions? 10 MR. NEWMAN: No questions. 11 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right, good 12 luck with your negotiation and if this matter is 13 not settled, the parties should send a mutual, a 14 consent agreement to extend the timeline to, with 15 the date and to our legal counsel, and the Board 16 will try to accommodate the schedule. All right? 17 MR. NEWMAN: Thank you. 18 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Thank you very 19 much and have a great day. 20 MR.
