MS. FLETCHER: Thank you for joining the Alcoholic Beverage Regulations Public Roll Call Hearing. My name is LaVerne Fletcher conducting the phone call hearing as the Board's agent. Can you hear me okay, Mr. Schlom? Can you hear me okay?

MR. SCHLOM: Yes, I can hear you just fine. Thank you.

MS. FLETCHER: You're welcome.

Today's hearing is being conducted through WebEx provided by the DC Office of Government. I'll take off my mask for a minute. I'm the only one in here right now.
