And so what about case number 22-251-00005? 6 7 MR. LUTES: Those, so the charges that 8 I listed out were for 22-251-00005. I'm happy to 9 read 22-CMP-00054 now. 10 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: I'm sorry Mr. 11 Lutes, I did ask you to read 22-CMP-00054. 12 MR. LUTES: Understood, apologies, I 13 misheard you. 14 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right, so 15 let's start off, because our calendar has 22-CMP-16 00054, what are the terms of that specific case 17 first? 18 MR. LUTES: Of course. So, for 22-CMP-19 00054, there's a single charge, an exceeded 20 summer garden occupancy limit, violating D.C. 21 Code Section 25762B2, and that will be a 4000 22 dollar fine payable within 120 days, or the 23 license shall be suspended indefinitely until the 24 fine is paid. 25 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right, thank

So, that's for 22-CMP-00054. Now there's 1 you. 2 another case, case number 22-251-00005. That 3 case is not on our calendar, however it's my 4 understanding that there is also a settlement for 5 that case. What are the terms then for that 6 case? 7 MR. LUTES: Yes Mr. Chairperson. The terms for case number 22-251-00005 are this. 8 9 Charge number one is a failure to follow security plan under D.C. Code Section 25823A6. 10 The board 11 will issue a warning for this charge. And then 12 regarding charge number two, it's a failure to 13 follow settlement agreement pursuant to D.C. Code Section 25823A6. 14 15 The district will seek a 250 dollar 16 fine payable within 120 days, or the license 17 shall be suspended indefinitely until the fine is 18 paid. 19 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right, thank All right, Mr. Shirafkan, it's my 20 you. 21 understanding that for case number 22-CMP-00054, 22 there is an offer in compromise. The offer in 23 compromise is a fine of 4000 dollars payable 24 within 120 days, if that fine is not paid, the 25 license will be suspended until the fine has been

And this settlement also covers case 1 paid. number 22-251-00005. 2 3 And in that case there are two 4 charges, the first charge, a warning will be 5 issued. The second charge, there is a fine of 250 dollars paid within 120 days, if that fine is 6 7 not paid within 120 days, the license will be 8 suspended until the fine has been paid. Is this 9 yours, and your client's understanding of the offer in compromise sir? 10 11 MR. SHIRAFKAN: It is our 12 understanding, and we can waive the execution of 13 the actual agreement, I've talked to the client, 14 they are in agreement, and yes. 15 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Is your client 16 also aware that this matter is not appealable? 17 They cannot appeal this. 18 MR.
