MS. FLETCHER: So, I'm just going to take a roll call, who I can see is present.

Mr. Roth, are you present? Mr. Roth?  
Mr. Irani, are you present?

Okay, just a second, thank you. Okay.  
Mr. Irani, can you hear me now?

MR. IRANI: Hello? Ms. Fletcher, your mic is muted. We can't hear anything.

MS. FLETCHER: What about now?

MR. IRANI: Can hear you loud and clear, yes.

MS. FLETCHER: Okay, so this is -- okay, so, so, who is present? Is Mr. Roth here?

MR. IRANI: He is here. I just spoke with him. But, his mic isn't connected, so he is on the phone though. He can hear us.

MS. FLETCHER: Okay, good. I'm just trying to see who is on the -- who is on the line.

Mr. Irani, are you here?

MR. IRANI: Present.

MS. FLETCHER: Mr. Walt -- can hear me.

1 Ms. Jones are you -- can you hear me?

2 MS. JONES: Yes, I'm here.

3 MS. FLETCHER: Okay.

4 What about Mr. Blumenthal?

5 MR. BLUMENTHAL: I'm here.

6 MS. FLETCHER: Okay.

7 Can you hear me and see me?

8 MR. BLUMENTHAL: I can only hear you.

9 MS FLETCHER: Oh, gee.

10 Okay, K.J. Hughes, can you hear me or  
11 see me?

12 MR. HUGHES: I can hear you and see  
13 you, thank you.

14 MS. FLETCHER: You can hear me and see  
15 me?

16 MR. HUGHES: Yes.

17 MS. FLETCHER: Okay.

18 What about -- okay, one second. Okay.

19 What about Ms. Meier? Can you hear me  
20 or see me? Ms. Meier? Okay.

21 MR. IRANI: It looks like her mic is  
22 muted.

23 MS. FLETCHER: Okay, so she can see  
24 me, but she can't -

25 MR. IRANI: Hello?

1 MS. FLETCHER: Yes, thank you.

2 MR. BLUMENTHAL: This is David  
3 Blumenthal. I can now see you on my screen.

4 PARTICIPANT: Oh, she got muted again.

5 MS. MEIER: Oh, now I'm -- I'm not  
6 muted. This is Felicia Meier. I just got it  
7 unmuted.

8 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Thank you.

9 MS. MEIER: Mm-hmm.

10 MS. FLETCHER: All right, one second  
11 please. Ms. Clarke, can you hear me? Laurie  
12 Clarke?

13 MR. IRANI: She's there, but her mic  
14 is muted.

15 MS. FLETCHER: I can't explain right  
16 now why on my end, I keep going back and forth  
17 with the mute and unmute. Just a second.

18 Can -- I'm going to tell you, if you  
19 can hear me, all of the names that I have -- just  
20 a second. Can everyone hear me now?

21 MS. JONES: Cassie can.

22 MS. CLARKE: Yes, Laurie Clarke can.

23 MS. FLETCHER: Okay.

24 MR. BLUMENTHAL: David Blumenthal can.

25 MS. MEIER: Felicia Meier can.

1 MS. FLETCHER: Okay, thank you. Is  
2 Sidon Yohannes on the line?

3 (Audio interference.)

4 MS. FLETCHER: Oh, because I don't see  
5 -- you can mute and unmute yourself too.

6 MS. FLETCHER: Okay, just a second.

7 PARTICIPANT: Okay, now I'm unmuted.

8 PARTICIPANT: Okay, thanks.

9 MS. FLETCHER: Okay, thank you.

10 One second, I'm just trying to make  
11 sure I've got everybody that's on the line.

12 Okay, I have Alan Roth, Mr. Irani,  
13 Cassandra Jones, David Blumenthal -

14 MR. ANDREW: -- is also here, but she  
15 is muted. Just dropped that in the chat along  
16 with Marcus Mirra.

17 MS. LEIGH: Leigh and Andrew Carter-  
18 Schuman are here.

19 MS. CARTER-SCHUMAN: I'm unmuted now,  
20 but - it's ridiculous.

21 PARTICIPANT: She's muted so she  
22 doesn't know that we can't hear her.

23 MS. YOHANNES: Hello, I'm here.

24 Sidon Yohannes, I can hear you.

25 MR. MIRRA: I've just been unmuted,

1 Marcus Mirra.

2 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you.

3 Ms. Hendricks, can you hear me?

4 MS. HENDRICKS: I can, yes, thank you,  
5 and I am now able to unmute. Thank you.

6 MS. FLETCHER: Okay, thank you.

7 Okay. So, I'm going to go down -- so,  
8 for anyone that can't hear me, I can't explain  
9 why you can't hear me. On my end it looks like  
10 you can hear me.

11 Sidon, you can't hear me?

12 MS. YOHANNES: Yes, I can hear you  
13 now.

14 MS. FLETCHER: Oh, okay.

15 So, on my end it appears that you can  
16 hear me, my -- my -- I can hear you but --

17 Okay, I'm getting some messages, so  
18 different people are in different situations, but  
19 I just want to make sure that everybody can hear  
20 me. But if for some reason you can't -- I am not  
21 -

22 Okay, thank you, Ms. Anica.

23 Um, so, on my end you are not -- no  
24 one is muted.

25 PARTICIPANT: George Boman says he is

1 still having trouble unmuting himself.

2 MS. FLETCHER: That's George?

3 PARTICIPANT: George and Anica are  
4 both still attendees rather than panelists, so  
5 they can't unmute themselves.

6 So, they need to be promoted.

7 MS. FLETCHER: Okay, just a second.

8 Thank you.

9 Just a second please.

10 PARTICIPANT: It's just a technical -

11 MS. FLETCHER: Who were those who  
12 needed to be elevated?

13 PARTICIPANT: George Boman and Anica  
14 Landreneau.

15 MS. FLETCHER: Okay, just a second.

16 PARTICIPANT: Laura, I'm in a meeting.

17 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Just a second.

18 PARTICIPANT: Oh, man.

19 MS. FLETCHER: I'm going -- I'm going  
20 to tell you, everyone, just a second.

21 Okay, Mr. Boman, I see you -- your  
22 mute -- I missed part of your message, just a  
23 minute.

24 So, I'm going to tell you right now,  
25 everyone, that according to what I can see,

1 everyone that has been elevated to the point that  
2 they can participate.

3 And I have a record that you are all  
4 here. So now I'm just going to go down this  
5 list.

6 I have Marcus Mirra, Alan Roth, Amir  
7 Irani, Cassandra Jones, David Blumenthal, Felicia  
8 Meier, K.J. Hughes, Laurie Clarke -- just a  
9 second.

10 Lee Farmer, Leigh and Andrew Carter-  
11 Schuman, Piper Hicks, Selma Thomas, Sidon  
12 Yohannes, T. Allan Campbell.

13 These are all the individuals that I  
14 have on my end who are present.

15 Is there anyone present that can't --  
16 that can't hear me or see me? Or who I haven't  
17 acknowledged?

18 PARTICIPANT: I believe Anica and  
19 George - George Boman --

20 MS. FLETCHER: Anica --

21 PARTICIPANT: Anica --Anica Landreneau  
22 and George Boman are on the line, but their -

23 MS. FLETCHER: I see -

24 PARTICIPANT: -- line is muted.

25 MS. FLETCHER: I saw -- on my end, it



1 is not muted.

2 But I am aware that Anica is on the  
3 line. And I am aware that -- let me see, one  
4 second, let me see - George Boman, can you hear  
5 me now?

6 MR. BOMAN: I can hear you.

7 MS. FLETCHER: Okay.

8 MR. BOMAN: Can you hear me?

9 MS. FLETCHER: I can hear you -

10 (Simultaneous speaking.)

11 PARTICIPANT: And it looks like --  
12 yes, we can hear -

13 PARTICIPANT: Ah, great.

14 MS. FLETCHER: Miss -

15 PARTICIPANT: It also looks like Mr.  
16 James is on the line too, Mr. Denis James. He's  
17 just -

18 (Simultaneous speaking.)

19 MS. FLETCHER: Okay, thank you.

20 Anica, can you hear me now?

21 MS. LANDRENEAU: I can and I've now  
22 been unmuted. Thank you.

23 MS. FLETCHER: Okay, thank you.

24 And so, Denis James is on the phone.

25 Okay. Denis James, can you hear me?

1 MR. JAMES: I can hear you.

2 MS. FLETCHER: Okay, I can hear you  
3 too.

4 MR. JAMES: Can you hear me?

5 MS. FLETCHER: Yes.

6 (Simultaneous speaking.)

7 MR. JAMES: Oh great, thank you.

8 MS. FLETCHER: You're welcome.

9 MR. JAMES: Hi, everyone.

10 MS. FLETCHER: Okay, so, looks like  
11 everyone is accounted for.

12 So, this is the only hearing on the  
13 calendar for today. So, thank you for  
14 participating in the roll call hearing via the  
15 WebEx system, which has been provided to us by  
16 the D.C. Office of Government.

17 I have a question though. Can  
18 everybody see me?

19 (Chorus of yes.)

20 MS. FLETCHER: Okay, good.

21 Okay.

22 This is Case Number PRO-00038, MAHK  
23 Meetings, LLC, trading as To Be Determined, 1806  
24 Vernon Street, NW, License Number ABRA 116881.  
25 This is a Retailer Class CT.

1                   This is an application to transfer to  
2                   a new location. And the protest issues are  
3                   adverse impact on peace, order and quiet,  
4                   residential parking and vehicular and pedestrian  
5                   safety, real property values and over-  
6                   concentration.

7                   Now, first of all, I would like to  
8                   apologize. Apparently there were two different  
9                   times for this -- for this roll call hearing  
10                  today. Some of you got the time for 9:30. On my  
11                  end, I have ten o'clock. So, for anyone that  
12                  signed on at 9:30, I apologize. I -- I , there  
13                  was a glitch somewhere along the line, but I will  
14                  go ahead and get started.

15                 Mr. Irani? Mr. Irani?

16                 MR. IRANI: Ms. Fletcher.

17                 MS. FLETCHER: Hi, I am just noting  
18                  that you are here on behalf of ANC-1C and that  
19                  ANC-1C does have standing as a protestant.

20                 And Mr. James?

21                 MR. JAMES: Yes.

22                 MS. FLETCHER: I'm acknowledging that  
23                  the Kalorama Citizens Association is present and  
24                  has standing as a protestant.

25                 MR. JAMES: Thank you

1 MS. FLETCHER: And you are welcome.

2 There is also a group of 23  
3 represented by Mr. Roth and Laurie Clarke.

4 Ms. Clarke, can you hear me?

5 MS. CLARKE: Yes.

6 MS. FLETCHER: Mr. Roth, can you hear  
7 me? Mr. Roth was there.

8 MR. IRANI: He should still be on the  
9 line, but his mic doesn't seem to be --

10 (Simultaneous speaking.)

11 MS. FLETCHER: Might be muted?

12 Okay, let me see.

13 So, Mr. Roth, I know he is here. I  
14 don't know what happened, um, -- to Mr. Roth. I  
15 can see that you are here though. All right,  
16 thank you.

17 So, there is some other individuals  
18 present on behalf of -- from the group of 23.

19 One second please.

20 So, from the group of 23, I see that  
21 Alan Roth is present, Laurie Clarke is present,  
22 Anica Landreneau -- I can't pronounce the last  
23 name, I'm sorry -- but you are present.

24 (Simultaneous speaking.)

25 MS. LANDRENEAU: Yes --

1 MS. FLETCHER: Mr. Carter --

2 Thank you.

3 Leigh Carter is present. Cassandra  
4 Jones, present. Let's see, one second.

5 Marcus Mirra, present; Alicia Meier,  
6 present; George Boman, present; Mr. Blumenthal, T  
7 Allan Campbell.

8 Did I miss anybody?

9 MS. THOMAS: Yes, Selma Thomas, also  
10 present.

11 MS. FLETCHER: Who is that?

12 MS. THOMAS: Selma Thomas.

13 MS. FLETCHER: Oh, Selma Thomas, okay.  
14 Oh, I see you down there. Just a  
15 second.

16 MS. THOMAS: Okay, thank you.

17 MS. FLETCHER: One second, let me  
18 check you off.

19 Okay, so Ms. Thomas is present.

20 Anybody else present that I didn't  
21 get?

22 Okay, well, I see that mister -  
23 (Simultaneous speaking.)

24 MS. THOMAS: Can we add Andrew  
25 Schuman?

1 MS. FLETCHER: Yes.

2 Yes, one second.

3 MR. SCHUMAN: Hi, I'm on.

4 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you, one second,  
5 Mr. Schuman.

6 (Simultaneous speaking.)

7 MR. SCHUMAN: I'm on.

8 MS. FLETCHER: Okay, so I've added Mr.  
9 Schuman.

10 Do I need to add anybody else? Okay.  
11 So the group of 23 has standing as a protestant  
12 because at least five of you are present today.

13 So, we are left with two abutting  
14 property owners.

15 Ms. Farmer, are you on the line?

16 MS. FARMER: I am. I am listed as Lee  
17 here, but I am Suzanne Farmer.

18 MS. FLETCHER: Oh, okay, thank you.

19 And what about -- what about Piper  
20 Hendricks?

21 MS. HENDRICKS: I am here as well.

22 MS. FLETCHER: Okay, thank you,  
23 because you are the two abutting property owners?

24 You filed your protests as abutting  
25 property owners?

1 MS. HENDRICKS: That's correct.

2 MS. FARMER: Yes.

3 MS. FLETCHER: I have, Ms. Yohannes,  
4 are you still here?

5 MS. YOHANNES: Yes, I'm here.

6 MS. FLETCHER: Okay, thank you.

7 Um, so, I have a question for you, Ms.  
8 Farmer, Ms. Hendricks. The question is the same.  
9 So, I checked the D.C. Geographic Information  
10 System and your buildings definitely abut the  
11 building of the establishment. I have to  
12 determine whether or not your units actually  
13 abut.

14 So, Ms. Farmer, you are in Unit 23?

15 MS. FARMER: Yes.

16 MS. FLETCHER: So, does your unit  
17 touch the establishment at any point? Does it  
18 actually touch it?

19 MS. FARMER: Yes.

20 MS. FLETCHER: I know the building --  
21 it does?

22 MS. FARMER: My living room and  
23 bedroom wall are on the -- what is that? Is that  
24 the eastern side of the building? So, it abuts  
25 the building next door.

1 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you.

2 That's your living room and bedroom  
3 wall?

4 MS. FARMER: Yes.

5 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you.

6 Ms. Hendricks, what about you?

7 MS. HENDRICKS: I'm identical, just  
8 one floor up. So, same floor plan, living room  
9 and bedroom both abutting.

10 MS. FLETCHER: So, but do they abut  
11 the establishment or what do they -- do they abut  
12 the establishment as well?

13 MS. HENDRICKS: They do.

14 My understanding is that they --  
15 depending on the floor level, I don't know if I  
16 am equal with the office space or the speakeasy  
17 space or where, but it is abutting the property.

18 MS. HENDRICKS: Okay, so, your --  
19 you're unit, you're Unit 33 touches the  
20 Applicant's unit somewhere?

21 MS. HENDRICKS: Yes, ma'am.

22 MS. HENDRICKS: Okay, thank you.

23 And you believe it is the living room  
24 and bedroom? Ms. Hendricks?

25 MS. HENDRICKS: Yes, that is correct.



1 Yes, living room and bedroom.

2 MS. FLETCHER: Okay.

3 MS. YOHANNES: And Ms. Fletcher?

4 MS. FLETCHER: Yes.

5 MS. YOHANNES: Um, as -- in regards to  
6 this two property, or to the two abutting  
7 property owners. I want to make the request that  
8 they submit additional information that shows  
9 that their actual units abut the establishment  
10 and the premises.

11 MS. FLETCHER: Okay, and what would  
12 you -- any particular information you two would  
13 find acceptable in terms of providing that, that  
14 information, Ms. Sidon Yohannes?

15 MS. YOHANNES: Um, no, I don't have  
16 any specific information we're requesting.

17 I don't see any information that has  
18 been provided showing that. In their letter they  
19 just state that they are abutting property  
20 owners. So, if they can just -- whether it is a  
21 floor plan, um, they can go onto the website and  
22 just show that the properties actually do abut  
23 that would be sufficient.

24 MS. FLETCHER: And so, the Applicant  
25 is not present today.

1                   Do you know, Ms. Yohannes, do you know  
2 whether or not the properties abut? I mean, I  
3 don't know if you've actually been to the  
4 establishment or -- but you don't have any  
5 knowledge of that at this point?

6                   I don't know if the Applicant would, I  
7 was just curious.

8                   MS. YOHANNES: I don't have any  
9 knowledge of that at this time.

10                  MS. FLETCHER: Okay, thank you.

11                  MS. FARMER: So, we would need to have  
12 access to the floor plans, um, for the proposed  
13 establishment, in order to provide you with that  
14 information.

15                  MS. YOHANNES: And I believe that they  
16 can provide that if they are saying that the  
17 buildings actually abut, they can provide that  
18 some portion of their unit actually abuts, it  
19 touches next, you know, the actual licensed  
20 establishment which is 1807 Florida Avenue,  
21 without having our floor plans.

22                  MS. FARMER: Well, we can absolutely  
23 show you a plan of 1812 Vernon Street and show  
24 you our floor plans and where they abut and that  
25 the two protestants with abutting properties --

1 where their units sit in 1812 Vernon Street.

2 So, if that is what you are looking  
3 for, we can show you that.

4 MS. YOHANNES: Yes, that's what I'm  
5 looking for.

6 MS. FARMER: Okay, that is no problem.

7 MS. FLETCHER: Okay, thank you.

8 MR. IRANI: Ms. Fletcher, this is Amir  
9 Irani on behalf of ANC-1C. We will be filing a  
10 motion to dismiss the application later this  
11 morning.

12 MS. FLETCHER: Okay, thank you. I'll  
13 make a note of that in the record. Thank you.

14 Let me see, and so, Ms. Farmer, what  
15 document is that that you are going to provide to  
16 the Applicant to show that your property abuts?

17 MS. FARMER: Well, I guess we need to  
18 figure out - I don't know that we have -- Anica,  
19 do you know -- we don't have floor plans of this  
20 building do we?

21 MS. LANDRENEAU: We have some very,  
22 um, they are like hand drawn, like duct layout  
23 like plans from when the building was converted  
24 during -- in '89, '90.

25 MS. FARMER: Okay.

1 MS. LANDRENEAU: That -- we can block  
2 out and show you where the stack for the X3  
3 units, you know, 03, 23, 33 are. We can show you  
4 where that is and then, you know, show you where  
5 that is next to the property in question.

6 So, I think that is what you are  
7 looking for, correct?

8 MS. FLETCHER: Ms. Yohannes, is that  
9 what you are looking for?

10 (Simultaneous speaking.)

11 PARTICIPANT: -- pretty good floor plan  
12 -- it's a pretty good floor plan in the condo  
13 docs that would show this.

14 MS. FARMER: Okay.

15 MS. HENDRICKS: I mean, I think it is  
16 what you need. It's, you know, that is what we  
17 have is from when this building was redone in  
18 1990.

19 So, yes, I think that's -- if that is  
20 what you are looking for is to show that stack of  
21 the, you know, X3 units and how they touch your  
22 building, that is what we have.

23 MS. FLETCHER: Okay, and Ms. Yohannes,  
24 would you find that acceptable?

25 MS. YOHANNES: I missed the -- I

1 apologize -- but I missed the first part of what  
2 -- I don't know who is speaking right now, or who  
3 was speaking, but the first part of what was  
4 being said. But I got the last part, which is  
5 you would submit floor plans, or you would submit  
6 something and I think a floor plan is in the --  
7 has already been provided, is that what you, is  
8 that what you just indicated?

9 I'm sorry, could you repeat what you  
10 just said?

11 MS. LANDRENEAU: It was a building plan  
12 for when they took over the AT&T building and we  
13 have a building plan that is hand drawn from  
14 1989, 1990, which did like a floor, kind of rough  
15 lay-out and drop lay-out, when it was conducted  
16 in 1989-90, which shows where there are four  
17 units per floor and there is a stack of the three  
18 units, that shows 23, 33, 43. And so, you are  
19 asking where 23 and 33 touch this building in  
20 question, and we can indicate for you where that  
21 is on the plan.

22 And so, I'm asking, is that a (audio  
23 interference)?

24 MS. YOHANNES: I mean, I think, I  
25 think that is fine and that is acceptable from

1        what you are saying, but then if I have a follow-  
2        up, or if I have motion that you can file based  
3        on what you have submitted, I will go ahead and  
4        do so.

5                    MS. LANDRENEAU: All right.

6                    MS. FLETCHER: And so the -- I'm  
7        sorry, go ahead.

8                    MS. YOHANNES: I'm sorry. I'm just  
9        making clear.

10                   Was that -- who was speaking?

11                   MS. LANDRENEAU: Sorry, that was Anica  
12        Landreneau.

13                   MS. YOHANNES: Okay.

14                   MS. HENDRICKS: And this is Piper  
15        Hendricks.

16                   Question, I guess I'm a little bit  
17        confused why we are discussing this now. As we  
18        had been adjudged abutting earlier this year.

19                   So, curious where the question is  
20        arising now?

21                   MS. FLETCHER: Well, so I -- from, so,  
22        where -- who determines to where abutting earlier  
23        this year, Ms. Hendricks?

24                   MS. HENDRICKS: I would need to go  
25        back and look through the earlier proceedings.

1                   This was, I believe, before -- before  
2 COVID, so I am trying to remember. It may have  
3 even been last year. We were meeting in person,  
4 um, and -

5                   MS. FLETCHER: These were ABRA -- ABRA  
6 proceedings?

7                   MS. HENDRICKS: I believe so, yes.

8                   MS. FLETCHER: And so, the buildings  
9 definitely abut. I mean, I can look at the -- at  
10 the geographic information system and see that  
11 the buildings abut for sure. The only question  
12 is whether or not the units abut.

13                   But if you have -- if you can show  
14 that, that is fine.

15                   MS. FARMER: Well, I think the point  
16 Piper is making is that both Piper and I were  
17 adjudged -- were judged to be abutting property  
18 owners previously by ABRA.

19                   MS. FLETCHER: If you were judged to  
20 be abutting property owners previously by ABRA --  
21 if you know what case that is, or you can  
22 determine what case that is, that would be  
23 sufficient.

24                   MS. FARMER: Okay.

25                   MS. YOHANNES: And I will just say and

1 note that that was in the previous application  
2 that was filed at that time, this matter, the  
3 application was withdrawn and a new one was  
4 filed.

5 There was not -- there wasn't any  
6 objections made during the roll call hearing  
7 before any motions or anything else were filed  
8 regarding standing, application withdrawn.

9 MS. FLETCHER: Okay, and so what I am  
10 going to do -- Mr. Irani, I've granted standing  
11 to the ANC and I'm going to include in the record  
12 and let the Board know that the ANC intends to  
13 file a motion to dismiss.

14 The Kalorama Citizens Association is  
15 granted standing on both -- I counted 23 -- is  
16 granted standing.

17 And so, Ms. Farmer and Ms. Hendricks,  
18 I am going to grant a conditional standing to you  
19 today. I am going to give you an opportunity to  
20 provide that information that you have.

21 The Board will grant a full standing  
22 at the status hearing. But for today we are just  
23 going proceed with conditional standing because  
24 the Applicant has requested, and you have agreed  
25 to provide, some information. So, I'm going to go



1 with that.

2 (Simultaneous speaking.)

3 MS. YOHANNES: Oh, sorry, go ahead.

4 MR. IRANI: Ms. Fletcher -- Ms.  
5 Fletcher, I just want to clarify that it is not  
6 just ANC-1C that will be providing the motion,  
7 but all the protestants.

8 MS. FLETCHER: Oh, all the -- okay.

9 MR. IRANI: Yes. Yes.

10 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you.

11 Well, I will go ahead and set the date  
12 for mediation just because we have to. And then,  
13 if the Board grants your application, you have a  
14 motion to dismiss the application then, I will  
15 just cancel it.

16 So, let's see here -

17 MS. YOHANNES: I'm sorry, can we make  
18 just one minor -- one minor note?

19 I think you said group of 23 -

20 MS. FLETCHER: Uh-huh.

21 MS. YOHANNES: And my counting could  
22 be wrong, but I believe that it is actually a  
23 group of 22.

24 MS. FLETCHER: Okay, I'll make it 22.  
25 Twenty-two is good. I say that because I'm

1 looking at my record and in the actual file I  
2 have a group of 22, but in my briefing it is 23.  
3 So, it's 22. It's 22 -- so, I'm just going to  
4 change -- it says 22 in the file, so we will make  
5 that a group of 22.

6 And so actually, what I am going to do  
7 is not schedule the mediation. I'm going to do  
8 it the opposite way. I'm not going to schedule  
9 the mediation if the protestants are going to  
10 file a motion to dismiss. I will let the Board  
11 make a ruling on that first.

12 If they don't dismiss the application,  
13 I'll know, and then I will contact you to  
14 schedule a mediation.

15 Any questions?

16 MR. BLUMENTHAL: Thank you, Ms.  
17 Fletcher.

18 MS. FLETCHER: You are very welcome.

19 Okay, well, does anybody have any  
20 questions? Okay, sorry for the technical issues  
21 this morning. Glad that I could see or hear  
22 everybody that I can and if there are no  
23 questions, anything on the Applicant's side, Ms.  
24 Yohannes?

25 MS. YOHANNES: No, no questions for

1 us, Ms. Fletcher. Thank you.

2 MS. FLETCHER: Okay.

3 Well then, I'm going to conclude the  
4 roll call hearing and I'm going to sign out, but  
5 thank you for participating.

6 PARTICIPANT: Thank you.

7 PARTICIPANT: Thank you.

8 PARTICIPANT: Thank you, have a good  
9 day.

10 MS. FLETCHER: Take care.

11 MS. YOHANNES: Thank you.
