3 MS. FLETCHER: I'm going to call the  
4 next case now. Calling the matter of Allure  
5 Lounge. This is Case Number 20-PRO-00041, 711 H  
6 Street, Northeast, License Number ABRA-108303.  
7 This is a Retailer Class CT, Substantial Change  
8 for Game of Skill Endorsement.

9 Is Mr. Wesson present on behalf of the  
10 establishment?

11 MR. WESSON: Yes, ma'am, I'm here.

12 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you, Mr. Wesson.  
13 Would you please spell your name for the record?

14 MR. WESSON: Yes, it's Bryan, B-R-Y-A-  
15 N, last name Wesson, W-E-S-S-O-N.

16 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you.

17 And Mr. Kelty?

18 MR. KELTY: Good morning. This is  
19 Commissioner Joel Kelty. J-O-E-L, K-E-L-T-Y.

20 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you very much,  
21 Mr. Kelty. And Mr. Kelty is present on behalf of  
22 ANC 6C.

23 Mr. O'Neal?

24 Okay, that is a separate matter, never  
25 mind. One second, please.

1 (Pause.)

2 MS. FLETCHER: The protest issues in  
3 this matter are adverse impact on peace, order,  
4 and quiet; residential parking; and vehicular and  
5 pedestrian safety.

6 And ANC 6C does have standing as a  
7 protestant.

8 We need to set a date for mediation.

9 MR. KELTY: We are also protesting on  
10 the basis of the effect -- adverse effect of  
11 property values as referenced in our letter.

12 MS. FLETCHER: And property values  
13 also? Okay, thank you.

14 Oh, yes, I see that now, thank you.

15 Okay, now we can set a date for  
16 mediation. I will give you the next day  
17 available. The next day available for mediation  
18 is Monday, October 19 at -- in the morning or  
19 afternoon up until 2:00. The time in the morning  
20 beginning at 10:00, I should say.

21 MR. KELTY: I, unfortunately, have a  
22 conflict on the 19th. Might we do it the  
23 following Monday, the 26th?

24 MS. FLETCHER: We sure can. We can do  
25 it on Monday the 26th at 11:30, 1:00 or 2:00.

1 MR. KELTY: 2:00 p.m. would be ideal  
2 for me, if that works with the Applicant.

3 MR. WESSON: That is fine with me.

4 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Thank you. I'm  
5 going to set mediation, then, for Monday, October  
6 26th at 2:00.

7 And I am going to be sending you a  
8 Webex invitation to join that mediation.

9 MR. WESSON: Thank you.

10 MS. FLETCHER: You'll get that just,  
11 you know, within -- at least within a week of the  
12 mediation.

13 Okay, well, thank you for  
14 participating.

15 MR. WESSON: Thank you.

16 MS. FLETCHER: You sign off whenever  
17 you are ready. Thank you.
