3 MS. FLETCHER: One more case on the
4 calendar today. This is the matter of Colony
5 Liquors, Case Number 24-PRO-00107, NG Liquor
6 Enterprises, LLC, 4901 Georgia Avenue NW, License
7 Number ABRA-122455. This is a Retailer Class A
8 license renewal. The protest issues are adverse
9 impact on peace, order, and quiet. My name is
10 LaVerne Fletcher conducting the roll call hearing
11 as the Board's agent. Is anyone present on

13 MR. SEYOUM: Good morning, Ms.
14 Fletcher. My name is Laban Seyoum. I am here on

20 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you. Is anyone

23 There is no one present on behalf of ANC 4D. ANC
24 4D is dismissed as a protestant. Mr. Seyoum?

25 MR. SEYOUM: Yes, ma'am?

1 MS. FLETCHER: The Board will issue an
2 order dismissing the protest, and you will
3 receive a copy of the order. If ANC 4D seeks
4 reinstatement of their protest you will receive a
5 copy of that request and have an opportunity to
6 respond to it. The Board will determine whether
7 or not to reinstate the protest. If ANC does not
8 request a reinstatement you will be aware of that
9 as well.

10 MR. SEYOUM: Thank you very much.

11 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you very much for
12 coming.

13 MR. SEYOUM: Have a wonderful morning.

14 MS. FLETCHER: Okay, you do the same.
15 Thank you.

16 MR. SEYOUM: Thank you.

17 MS. FLETCHER: You are welcome. Okay.
18 Is there anyone else present that I have not
19 spoken with, or that I need to speak with?

20 Okay. The roll call hearings are
