The first case in our legal agenda, it's review of an offer in compromise in lieu of a hearing, dated October 5th, 2022, for Case No. 20-CIT00018, Moi Moi Restaurant, License No. 120466.

The offer in compromise is Charge 1, allowed the establishment to be used for unlawful purpose, statutory authority, D.C. Code Section 25-823(a)(2). For Charge 1, 1,000-dollar fine payable within 120 days of the Board accepting the OIC. And if payment is not made within 120 days, the license will be suspended until payment has been made.

Charge 2, allowed a third party or promoter to provide security, statutory authority, D.C. Code Section 25-797(b). There's a fine of 1,000 dollars payable within 120 days of the Board accepting the offer in compromise. If payment is not made within 120 days, the license will be suspended until payment is
received.
Charge 3, interference with an investigation by making false statements, statutory authority, D.C. Code Section 25823(a)(5). The fine is 1,000 dollars payable within 120 days of the Board accepting the officer in compromise. And if payment is not made within 120 days, the license will be suspended until payment has been made. I therefore make a motion that the offer in compromise be accepted. Is there a second? MEMBER GRANDIS: Ed Grandis will second.

Code Section 25-701.

There's a fine of 250 dollars payable within 120 days or the license shall be suspended indefinitely until the fine has been paid. I therefore make a motion that the offer in compromise be accepted. Is there a second?
