The Alcoholic Beverage and Cannabis Board met via WebEx videoconference, LaVerne Fletcher, Board's Agent, presiding.

3 MS. FLETCHER: Okay, so, good morning,
4 again, everyone.

5 Thank you for participating in ABRA's
6 public roll call hearing today via the WebEx
7 platform.

8 My name is Laverne Fletcher conducting
9 the roll call hearing as the Board's agent.

10 There are two cases on the calendar
11 today.

12 The first case is Minya's Pizza. This
13 is Case Number 23-PRO-00077, Zingo Pizzeria, LLC,
14 1932 9th Street, North West, License Number ABRA
15 125665.

16 This is a Retailer Class CR new
17 application.

18 The protest issues are adverse impact
19 on peace, order, and quiet.

20 This is Laverne Fletcher conducting
21 the roll call hearing as the Board's agent.

22 Is anyone present on behalf of
23 Minya's?

24 (NO AUDIBLE RESPONSE)

25 MS. FLETCHER: Is anyone present on

1 behalf of Minya's?

2 (NO AUDIBLE RESPONSE)

3 MS. FLETCHER: Is anyone present on
4 behalf of ANC 1B?

5 MR. SCHLOM: Yes, yes, Ms. Fletcher,
6 good morning.

7 Evan Schlom, that's E, V as in Victor,
8 A, N as in Nancy. Last name is S as in Sam, C as
9 in Charlie, H-L-O, M as in Mary, on behalf of ANC
10 1B.

11 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you, Mr. Schlom.

12 And I did receive a message this
13 morning that you would be representing ANC 1B
14 today, thank you.

15 MR. SCHLOM: Thank you.

16 MS. FLETCHER: Is anyone present on
17 behalf of Minya's?

18 (NO AUDIBLE RESPONSE)

19 MS. FLETCHER: I am going to move
20 along to the next case, recall this case.

21 We allow parties at least ten minutes
22 to appear in case they're having technical
23 difficulty.

24 The time is approximately 10:05. So,
25 I'm going to end this case for now and call the

1 next case and I'll recall this case shortly.

2 (Whereupon, the above-entitled matter
3 went off the record at 10:06 a.m. and resumed at
4 10:52 a.m.)

5 MS. FLETCHER: I am recalling the case
6 of Minya's Pizza.

7 Mr. Schlom?

8 MR. SCHLOM: Yes?

9 MS. FLETCHER: Okay.

10 Is anyone present yet from Minya's
11 Pizza?

12 (NO AUDIBLE RESPONSE)

13 MS. FLETCHER: Okay, the time is
14 approximately 10:50.

15 There's no one present on behalf of
16 Minya's Pizza.

17 The new application is dismissed
18 because the Applicant is not present.

19 Mr. Schlom, once the Board issues the
20 Order dismissing this protest, you'll receive a
21 copy of the Order and, if the Applicant seeks
22 reinstatement, you'll be informed, or the ANC 1B
23 will be information and have an opportunity to
24 respond to the Motion for Reinstatement.

25 MR. SCHLOM: Understood, thank you

1 very much, Ms. Fletcher.

2 MS. FLETCHER: Mr. Schlom, may I ask
3 you something?

4 MR. SCHLOM: Sure.

5 MS. FLETCHER: Do you want me to --
6 beyond today, do you want me to send emails to
7 ANC 1B?

8 I know you're here representing them
9 today. Do you want me to go back to sending
10 emails to them directly?

11 MR. SCHLOM: Yes, for the record, it's
12 probably best that they be sent to the ANC 1B
13 email, whatever the email that was listed in the
14 protest letter that I know ABCA normally uses.

15 I just don't want there to be any
16 miscommunications on that.

17 MS. FLETCHER: Okay.

18 MR. SCHLOM: But thank you for asking
19 and confirming. I appreciate it.

20 MS. FLETCHER: Well, you are very
21 welcome. I appreciate it and we'll see what
22 happens next.

23 Thanks for coming.

24 MR. SCHLOM: Thank you very much, take
25 care.

1 MS. FLETCHER: You're very welcome.

2 MR. SCHLOM: Bye-bye.

3 MS. FLETCHER: Bye-bye.

4 Mr. Lee? I saw someone by the name of
5 Mr. Lee. I don't see Mr. Lee anymore.

6 I was checking to see if Mr. Lee was
7 a party in either one of these cases.

8 Mr. Lee, your telephone number ends in
9 07. Did you need to speak with me today?

10 COURT REPORTER: Oh no, that's me.
11 I'm the court reporter. This is my backup phone.

12 MS. FLETCHER: Oh, okay.

13 Well, that settles that, thank you
14 very much.
