20	with your voice, sir. I've seen you before so if
21	you don't have a camera, that's fine for this
22	proceeding.
23	Good afternoon, Mr. Southcott. Can
24	you please spell and state your name for the
25	record.

1	MR. SOUTHCOTT: Good afternoon, Mr.
2	Chair. This is Chris Southcott. First name C-H-
3	R-I-S, last name S-O-U-T-H-C-O-T-T from D.C.'s
4	Office of the Attorney General representing the
5	Government.
6	CHAIRPERSON DONOVAN: Good afternoon.
7	Mr. Jablonski, can you spell and state
8	your name for the record.
9	MR. JABLONSKI: Absolutely. My name
10	is Gaynor Jablonski spelled G-A-Y-N-O-R, last
11	name J-A-B-L-O-N-S-K-I.
12	CHAIRPERSON DONOVAN: Thank you, sir.

SOUTHCOTT: I will be sure to pass 6 that on to my colleague whose case this is. 7 MR. JABLONSKI: Okay. Thank you. 8 CHAIRPERSON DONOVAN: All right. This matter then is scheduled for a show-case hearing 9 on November 15th at 10:30 a.m. I would like to 10 11 remind both parties that seven days before the 12 hearing you're required to exchange documents and 13 witnesses. 14 The documents must be provided to the 15 other side and to our legal office. Failure by either side to disclose documents or witnesses 16 17 seven days prior to the hearing, unless 18 reasonable cause is shown, then the Board is 19 empowered to prevent that side from moving 20 forward with relying on documents and witnesses 21 that have not been disclosed. Any questions by 2.2 anyone? 23 MR. SOUTHCOTT: Nothing from the 2.4 Government.
