CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And we will now do our agenda items for the morning. And so we'll start off with our legal agenda. The first matter on our legal agenda is a review of an offer in compromise in lieu of a hearing dated October 31, 2022, for Case Number 22-CMP-00047, Boulevard Lounge, License Number 115385. The offer in compromise is as follows. Charge one, interfering in the ABRA investigation, statutory authority DC Code Section 25-823(A)(5). The fine is a fine of $\$ 1,000.00$ payable within 30 days, or the license shall be suspended indefinitely until the fine is paid.

Charge number 2, no ABC managers, statutory authority DC Code Section 25-701. There is a $\$ 250.00$ fine payable within 30 days, or the license shall be suspended indefinitely until the fine has been paid.

Charge number 3, operating outside of approved hours, statutory authority DC Code Section 25-762 (B)(13). There is a fine of \$1,000.00 payable within 30 days, or the license shall be suspended indefinitely until the fine

Charge number 2, failed to keep books and records for three years, statutory authority DC Code Section 25-112(C)(2)(a). There is a fine of $\$ 1,000.00$ payable within 30 days, or the license shall be suspended indefinitely until the fine is paid.

Charge number 3, interfered in an ABRA investigation by providing false and misleading statements. Statutory authority, DC Code Section 25-823(A)(5). There will be a warning issued for this charge.

Charge number 4, sold alcoholic beverages to unpremised retailers' licenses, statutory authority DC Code Section 25-823(A)(1). There is a fine of $\$ 1,000.00$ payable within 30 days, or the license shall be suspended indefinitely until the fine has been paid. I, therefore, make a motion that the Board accepts this offer in compromise. Is there a second?
