3 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And we will now
4 do our agenda items for the morning. And so
5 we'll start off with our legal agenda. The first
6 matter on our legal agenda is a review of an
7 offer in compromise in lieu of a hearing dated
8 October 31, 2022, for Case Number 22-CMP-00047,
9 Boulevard Lounge, License Number 115385. The
10 offer in compromise is as follows. Charge one,
11 interfering in the ABRA investigation, statutory
12 authority DC Code Section 25-823(A)(5). The fine
13 is a fine of \$1,000.00 payable within 30 days, or
14 the license shall be suspended indefinitely until
15 the fine is paid.

16 Charge number 2, no ABC managers,
17 statutory authority DC Code Section 25-701.
18 There is a \$250.00 fine payable within 30 days,
19 or the license shall be suspended indefinitely
20 until the fine has been paid.

21 Charge number 3, operating outside of
22 approved hours, statutory authority DC Code
23 Section 25-762 (B)(13). There is a fine of
24 \$1,000.00 payable within 30 days, or the license
25 shall be suspended indefinitely until the fine

1 has been paid. That is the offer in compromise.
2 I make a motion that the offer in compromise be
3 approved. Is there a second?

4 MEMBER SHORT: Mr. Short, I second.

5 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Short and
6 I heard Mr. Cato has second the motion. We'll
7 now have a roll call vote on the motion. Mr.
8 Short?

18 Number 2, review of an offer in
19 compromise in lieu of a hearing dated October 31,
20 2022, for Case Number 22-CMP-00030, Potomac Wine
21 and Spirits, License Number 001926. The offer in
22 compromise is as follows. Charge one, held a
23 conflicting interest in a Maryland wholesaler's
24 license, statutory authority DC Code Section 25-
25 303(A)(3). There is a fine of \$1,000.00 payable

1 within 30 days, or the license shall be suspended
2 indefinitely until the fine is paid.

3 Charge number 2, failed to keep books
4 and records for three years, statutory authority
5 DC Code Section 25-112(C)(2)(a). There is a fine
6 of \$1,000.00 payable within 30 days, or the
7 license shall be suspended indefinitely until the
8 fine is paid.

9 Charge number 3, interfered in an ABRA
10 investigation by providing false and misleading
11 statements. Statutory authority, DC Code Section
12 25-823(A)(5). There will be a warning issued for
13 this charge.

14 Charge number 4, sold alcoholic
15 beverages to unpremised retailers' licenses,
16 statutory authority DC Code Section 25-823(A)(1).
17 There is a fine of \$1,000.00 payable within 30
18 days, or the license shall be suspended
19 indefinitely until the fine has been paid. I,
20 therefore, make a motion that the Board accepts
21 this offer in compromise. Is there a second?

22 MEMBER GRANDIS: Ed Grandis will
23 second

24 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Grandis has
25 second the motion. We'll now have a roll call

17 Liquor, License Number 106557. The offer in
18 compromise is as follows. Charge 1, sale of
19 alcoholic beverage to a minor, statutory
20 authority, DC Code Section 25-781. There is a
21 fine of \$2,000.00 payable within 30 days, or the
22 license shall be suspended indefinitely until the
23 fine is paid.

24 Number 2, suspension. The
25 Respondent's ABC License shall be suspended for

1 five days with all five days stayed for one year.
2 Number 3 are the terms; training, all employees
3 who sell/serve alcoholic beverages in the
4 licensed establishment shall complete an alcohol
5 training program within three months from the
6 date of the OIC.

7 Charge 3, failure to take reasonable
8 steps necessary to ascertain legal drinking age,
9 statutory authority DC Code Section 25-783.

10 There is a \$1,000.00 fine payable within 30 days,
11 or the license shall be suspended indefinitely
12 until the fine has been paid. I make a motion
13 that the ABC Board accept this OIC. Is there a
14 second?

15 MEMBER SHORT: Mr. Short, I second.

16 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Short has
