3 MR. ADOFO: Good morning.

4 MS. FLETCHER: Good morning, Mr.

5 Adofo.

6 MR. ADOFO: Yeah, I was wondering if
7 we were still having the hearing for the Wonder
8 Mart?

9 MS. FLETCHER: Oh, yeah, just a
10 second. I'm going to call the case in a minute.

11 MR. ADOFO: Oh, okay.

12 (Pause.)

13 MS. FLETCHER: Mr. Adofo? Just making
14 sure you can hear me. Okay, thank you. I'm
15 going to call your case now.

16 This is case number 20-PRO-00048,
17 Wonder Mart, LLC trading as Wonder Mart, 1300 4th
18 Street, SE, license number ABRA-116997. This is
19 a Retailer Class B. It's a new application.

20 The protest issues are adverse impact
21 on peace, order, and quiet, residential parking,
22 and vehicular and pedestrian safety.

23 I don't see the applicant on the line.
24 Is the applicant present? Mr. Adofo, have you
25 been in communication with the applicant?

1 MR. ADOFO: No, ma'am.

2 MS. FLETCHER: So, there is not a
3 draft settlement agreement or anything, any --

4 MR. ADOFO: No, ma'am.

5 MS. FLETCHER: Okay, thank you very
6 much. Mr. Adofo, you're representing ANC 8C?

7 MR. ADOFO: Yes, ma'am.

8 MS. FLETCHER: Would you please spell
9 your name for the record?

10 MR. ADOFO: S-A-L-I-M A-D-O-F-O.

11 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you. The time is
12 approximately 10:55 a.m. The applicant is not
13 present for the roll call hearing. Therefore,
14 the application is dismissed.

15 Mr. Adofo, what that means is that the
16 ABC Board is going to issue an order dismissing
17 the application because the applicant is not
18 present today.

19 The ANC will receive a copy of that
20 order. If the applicant seeks reinstatement of
21 the application, you will be informed and you'll
22 have an opportunity to respond to that, and when
23 we'll go from there.

24 MR. ADOFO: Yes, ma'am.

25 MS. FLETCHER: If the application is

1 reinstated, I'll contact you. Then we would need
2 to schedule a mediation. You would need a status
3 hearing before the Board, but that wouldn't
4 happen unless the application is reinstated, if
5 he seeks reinstatement.

6 MR. ADOFO: Yes, ma'am.

7 MS. FLETCHER: Any questions about
8 that?

9 MR. ADOFO: No, ma'am.

10 MS. FLETCHER: Okay, well, thank you
11 very much for participating today. The roll call
12 hearing is concluded.

13 MR. ADOFO: Yes, ma'am, thank you.

14 MS. FLETCHER: Okay, thank you.
15 You're very welcome, bye-bye.
