Cause Hearing, that at the show cause hearing

Respondent may be represented by legal counsel, have subpoenas issued to require the production of witnesses and evidence, produce witnesses and evidence, cross examine witnesses, and apply to the Board for a qualified interpreter.

The charge is -- Charge 1 is increasing the interior occupancy of the licensed establishment in violation of Section 2582387.

The statutory authority is Section 823(a)(1).

The fine is a written warning.
