8	MR. ORELLANA: Cordelia Lu, your			
9	access has been elevated. That is all, Chairman.			
10	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Thank you.			
11	MS. LU: Good morning.			
12	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right.			
13	Good morning. Mr. Bianco, can you identify

5	MR. BIANCO: There are not. We have		
6	a mediation on the books, we have not yet engaged		
7	in it. If there is anything to report following		
8	the mediation, we will certainly do so, in		
9	writing, to the Board. If we have a resolution,		
10	the Board can act on it in due course.		
11	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Thank you, sir.		
12	Ms. Lu, any preliminary matters you need to bring		
13	to the attention of the Board?		
14	MS. LU: No, not at this time.		
15	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right.		
16	This matter is scheduled for a Protest Hearing on		
17	December 14th at 1:30 p.m. Are the parties		
18	familiar with the guidelines in having a Protest		
19	Hearing?		
20	MR. BIANCO: For the Applicant, yes,		
21	we are. We'll waive any reading of the		
22	guidelines.		
23	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Lu?		
24	MS. LU: I would not mind a rereading		
25	of the guidelines.		

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right.

Hold -- all right, yes, ma'am. All right.

MS. LU: Thank you.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Now that we have scheduled this matter for a Protest Hearing, there are a few things that I would like to instruct the Applicant and the Protestant about, so that the Protest Hearing is focused and addresses only those issues that are being protested. The Board does not intend to hear testimony in matters that are not relevant to this case.

You should have received by electronic or regular mail, a letter explaining the protest process, a copy of the protest information form, and a copy of the exhibit form. If you do not have these forms, please contact our legal office following the hearing. It is imperative that you review the rules closely and adhere to them before entering the Protest Hearing.

You are also required to complete and submit the protest information form, PIF, and the exhibit form, seven days before the date of the hearing. These two forms and accompanying documents need to be submitted to ABCA's Legal

Division and to all opposing parties in this matter.

If we do not receive a copy of your PIF, your Application, or your protests, whichever side you representing, may be subject to dismissal. Likewise, if we do not receive a copy of the exhibit form, and the exhibits themselves, your exhibits may be excluded from the record upon a finding that the opposing party has been prejudiced, or no good cause for the failure to submit, has been shown.

Likewise, witnesses other than a party may also be subject to exclusion, if not identified on the PIF. Accordingly, these forms are very important, they greatly assist the Board in narrowing the protest issues, facilitating the process, and keeping the parties on point during the hearing. They likewise, provide notice to the opposing parties, enabling them to better prepare for the hearing.

Also, as you are aware, all our hearings are now conducted virtually. You will have one hour to present your case, and you will only be allowed to have 5 witnesses. If you require more time, please file a motion with the
