Market, License Number 94523. 6 7 Mr. Orellana, can you please elevate 8 the rights of the parties in this case, please? 9 MR. ORELLANA: Aaron Caple, your access has been elevated. Chris Tyner, your 10 11 access has been elevated. O'Brien, your access 12 has been elevated. Vanessa Pleitez, your access has been elevated. 13 14 That is all, Chairman. 15 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Okay. Who is 16 a protestant? Do we have someone from -- okay. 17 He's there. 18 I'm sorry. Do we have someone from 19 the Blagden I guess it's a -- from -- do we 20 have a protestant here from -- from Banca? Is 21 there a representative from Banca here? 22 I guess from what I'm hearing, there's 23 quiet, so there is no representative from Banca?

MR. ORELLANA: There is no one in the

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: There's no one in the waiting area.

This is Case Number 22-PRO-00083.

This is a protest hearing that was scheduled for 1:30. So let me -- let me have the parties identify themselves for the record. Let's start with Mr. O'Brien. Mr. O'Brien, can you please identify yourself for the record, please?

MR. O'BRIEN: Yes. Stephen O'Brien for the Licensee, S-T-E-P-H-E-N O apostrophe capital B-R-I-E-N. And I'm accompanied by two representatives of the Licensee.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. Who are the representatives, Mr. O'Brien, who are here?

MR. O'BRIEN: Christopher Tyner, C-H-R-I-S-T-O-P-H-E-R T-Y-N-E-R, and Aaron Caple, A-A-R-O-N C-A-P-L-E.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: This matter was scheduled for a protest hearing for today at 1:30. But it's 2:29, and I do not see a protestant. And I have been told that we have not -- I've been -- well, I -- I have not seen a protestant.

1	And I Mr. O'Brien, are you trying
2	to get my attention, or somewhere else?
3	MR. O'BRIEN: I was trying to get your
4	attention, Mr. Chair.
5	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Yes, Mr.
6	O'Brien.
7	MR. O'BRIEN: I would point out two
8	things. Number one, the protestant did not file
9	a PIP by last Wednesday's deadline. Number two,
10	I am told I do not have personal knowledge
11	that the same protestant recently pulled a no
12	show for the a protest hearing before the
13	Board.
14	So when you take those two factors
15	into account, frankly, I'm not surprised that the
16	protestant is absent.
17	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Thank you, Mr.
18	O'Brien.
19	Ms. Pleitez, can you identify yourself
20	for the record, please?
21	MS. PLEITEZ: Vanessa Pleitez, V-A-N-
22	E-S-S-A, last name is Pleitez, P-L-E-I-T-E-Z.
23	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Pleitez,
24	you did it is there a case report for this
25	case?

1	MS. PLEITEZ: Yes.			
2	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Have you had an			
3	opportunity to interview the protestant in this			
4	case?			
5	MS. PLEITEZ: No. I tried to contact			
6	him via email, three different occasions			
7	October 24th, October 25th, and October 31st and			
8	he has not responded as of today.			
9	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Who is this			
10	individual that you have attempted to			
11	MS. PLEITEZ: Mr. Robert Goldberg.			
12	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Can you spell			
13	that for the record, please?			
14	MS. PLEITEZ: Yes. R-O-B-E-R-T, last			
15	name Goldberg, G-O-L-D-B-E-R-G.			
16	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Thank you. Do			
17	you have a motion, Mr. O'Brien?			
18	MR. O'BRIEN: Yes, sir. We move to			
19	dismiss this protest for want of prosecution.			
20	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: There is a			
21	motion to counsel has made a motion for want			
22	of prosecution based on the failure of the			
23	protestant to to appear. And so, therefore			
24	so I'm going to I'm asking the Board to vote			
25	to dismiss this matter based on the failure of			

the protestant to appear.

I just want to also correct the record. I had -- Ms. Pleitez also had testified that, as the investigator in this case, that she had attempted to -- that she had attempted to contact the protestant on three occasions, and he failed to appear.

And as stated by counsel, a PIP was not submitted by the protestant in this particular case. And a PIP is that seven days prior to the hearing both parties are -- were required to provide documents and witnesses to the Board, all the documents and witnesses that they would rely on if this matter went to a protest hearing, and that was not filed.

So, therefore, I -- I'll vote in favor of the -- let me do a roll call vote on the motion. Mr. Cato?

MEMBER CATO: Bobby Cato. I agree.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Crockett?

MEMBER CROCKETT: Agree.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Hansen?

MEMBER HANSEN: Jeni Hansen. I agree.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: I agree. The

matter passes four-zero-zero.

The Board will issue a Board order on our motion today. Normally, when we issue an order dismissing the matter, the protestant is given -- the other side is given 10 days to respond to the order to give us reasonable notice why they failed to appear today.

And so we await -- so we'll wait -- so the Board will issue an order dismissing the protest. And what this means is that once the order is issued the protestant will be given 10 days to respond to -- and the Board will -- if a response is made, the Board will make a determination on -- on what's in their response.

But if that's not -- if the Board determines that good cause has not been shown why the protestant was -- failed to prosecute this matter, the Board will allow the agency to move forward with the -- this is a renewal? The Board would allow the agency to move on with the -- move forward with the process.

So we're not -- we're not approving the renewal in this -- in this matter, but the agency will -- would be empowered to move forward with the renewal application. Okay?

MR. O'BRIEN: Yes, sir.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Thank you.

Thank you very much for being here today. Have a great day. Thank you.

And that protest was the last matter on our calendar today. And so with that, I'm going to officially close the record.

As Chairperson of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board for the District of Columbia, in accordance with D.C. Federal Code Section 2575B and 2575B-14 of the Open Meetings Act, I move that ABC Board hold a closed meeting on November 30, 2022, for the purpose of discussing and hearing reports concerning ongoing or planned investigations of alleged criminal or civil misconduct or violations of law or regulations and seeking legal advice from our legal counsel on the matters identified on the Board's legal, license, and investigative agenda for November 30, 2022, as published in the D.C. Register on November 25th. I believe it's November 25th, if November 25th is not a holiday after Thanksgiving. 2022.
