4	calendar is Deset Ethiopian Restaurant, Case
5	Number 25-PRO-00102. Deset Ethiopian Restaurant,
6	LLC, 6128 Georgia Avenue, NW, License Number
7	ABRA098818. This is a Retailer Class CT Tavern
8	License Renewal. The protest issues are adverse
9	impact on peace, order, and quiet, real property
10	values, residential parking needs, and vehicular
11	and pedestrian safety. My name is LaVerne
12	Fletcher, conducting the role call hearing as the
13	Board's agent. Is anyone present on behalf of
14	Deset Ethiopian Restaurant?
15	MR. ARAYA: Hi, my name is Desta
16	Araya, 6128 Georgia Avenue.
17	MS. FLETCHER: Thank you very much,
18	Mr. Araya. Is anyone present on behalf of ANC
19	4A?
20	MS. EDWARDS: Hello, I am Paula
21	Edwards, Chair of ANC 4A. How are you, Ms.
22	Fletcher?
23	MS. FLETCHER: Good morning, Ms.
24	Edwards. How are you today?
25	MS. EDWARDS: Fine, thank you.

1	MS. FLETCHER: Is anyone else with you
2	today, Commissioner?
3	MS. EDWARDS: Commissioner Alex Akula
4	is designated as the primary, but I do not know
5	if he is on the call today.

- 17 MS. FLETCHER: Okay, so what did you -
- 18 | well, can you tell me your name, please, since
- 19 | you are present?
