The first agenda item that we will address today, it's our legal agenda. The first matter on our legal agenda is a review of an Offer in Compromise in lieu of a hearing dated November 15, 2022, for Case No. 23-CMP-00058, Tokyo Pearl. The terms of the Offer in Compromise are as follows:

For charge one, increase interior occupancy without approval, Statutory Authority D.C. Code Section 25-762(b)(1). There shall be a \$2,000 fine payable within 30 days or the license shall be suspended indefinitely until the fine has been paid.

For charge number two, failed to follow security agreement by exceeding interior occupancy, Statutory Authority D.C. Code Section 25-823(a)(6). This charged has been dismissed.
