LUI: Good afternoon, Mr. Chairperson, John Lui on behalf of the 6 7 government. That's J-O-H-N L-U-I. 8 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Now, is there 9 -- who is the owner? Is there a representative 10 or is there an attorney and an owner as far as 11 the establishment is concerned? 12 MS. KHAN: Correct, Mr. Chairperson. 13 My name is Sara Khan on behalf of Johnny 14 Pistolas, S-A-R-A, last name K-H-A-N, and with me 15 is a representative from the company, Elizabeth 16 Makris, E-L-I-Z-A-B-E-T-H, last name Makris, M-A-17 K-R-I-S. 18 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right, 19 thank you. Thank you, Ms. Khan. Are there any 20 preliminary matters in this case? 21 MR. LUI: Mr. Chairman, the parties do 22 not have an offer in compromise to present at 23 this time. 24 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. 25 MS. KHAN: I have --

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Yes, Ms. Khan?

And based on the fact that he wouldn't be able to testify and was the main witness that would be able to provide any event on behalf of Johnny Pistolas and proof it was a private event, I would request that it be dismissed on that because of the prejudice to the entity, and Ms. Makris is involved on the basis that this was her father that passed away. So, we're willing to hear from the government.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: I'm sorry to hear that, but I'm not sure if the government is ready to entertain that, but that's not the Board. The Board on its own motion cannot make a determination on that because that's up to the government.

If the government wants to entertain that at this juncture, they can, or if the parties want to further discuss this, the only thing that the Board would do at this juncture, unless the government says otherwise, is to schedule this matter for a show cause hearing at a date to be determined.

In the interim, the parties can discuss whether or not they determine that this is a matter that should move forward or can be dismissed, or there can be a compromise, and if something is presented to the Board by the government and the licensee, of course the Board will entertain it.

MR. LUI: Mr. Chairman?

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Yes, Mr. Lui?

MR. LUI: The government will respond

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right, so this matter then will be scheduled for a show cause hearing at a date to be determined, and I will advise both parties to continue speaking.

If the parties agree to dismiss this matter, the parties can advise the Board.

If the parties agree to have an offer in compromise, that can be sent in writing to the Board and the Board will vote on it on its legal agenda, but if no agreement can be reached, then we will set a date to be determined for a show cause hearing, okay?

MS. KHAN: Thank you.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And my condolences to you, Mr. Makris, on the death of, you said it was your father? My condolences.

Your microphone is off, yeah.

MS. MAKRIS: Sorry, yes, that's correct.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: On behalf of the Board, my condolences to you and your family, okay? So, but thank you for your appearance today and the parties will inform us --

We'll inform you of the date and the time of the show cause hearing and the parties will inform the Board what their position is, whether or not we're going to move forward with this matter, okay?

MS. KHAN: Thank you, Mr. Chairperson, sorry, just one brief question. Do I reach out to you or should I continue to discuss with
