CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: The next case on our calendar is Case Number 20-PRO-00027, The Game Sports Pub/Tiki on 18th, License Number 112308.

Ms. Andrews, can you please elevate the rights of the parties in this case, please?

MS. ANDREWS: Sure. Stand by.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Thank you.

MS. YOHANNES: Hi. Mr. Chairman, I just received an email or sorry a call from the ANC representative, Amir, and he's trying to log on right now. Can I give Ms. Andrews his email address and can she --

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: You can provide us with whatever login credentials the person is using so she'll know to elevate their rights.

MS. ANDREWS: Ms. Yohannes, you can email me that information. I'm not sure if we want that in the public record. I'm going to unmute the line for the phone number beginning in 705. Could you please announce yourself?

15	MS. ANDREWS: Mm-hmm.	
16	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Do we know if	
17	the person has gotten the email to log in?	
18	MS. YOHANNES: I'm confirming that	
19	right now.	
20	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Thank you.	
21	MS. YOHANNES: He did get the link.	
22	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Thank you.	
23	MS. ANDREWS: Mr. Chair, I do see him	
24	on the line. I'm going to go ahead and make him	
25	a panelist.	

1	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Thank you.	
2	MR. IRANI: Hello there.	
3	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right.	
4	Okay. So this is Case Number 20-PRO-00027, The	
5	Game Sports Pub/Tik on 18th, License Number	
6	112308. Let's have the parties introduce	
7	themselves for the record, spell their name.	
8	We'll start with the licensee.	
9	MS. YOHANNES: Sidon Yohannes on	
10	behalf of the licensee. And that is S-I-D-O-N Y-	
11	O-H-A-N-N-E-S.	
12	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And let's have	
13	the protestant starting with the ANC spell your	
14	name identify yourself and spell your name for	
15	the record, please.	
16	MR. IRANI: Amir Irani, A-M-I-R I-R-A-	
17	N-I, and representing 1C01, ANC 1C.	
18	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And we have the	
19	Civic Association.	
20	MR. JAMES: Good morning, again.	
21	Denis James, President of Kalorama Citizens	
22	Association. Denis is spelled with just one N,	
23	J-A-M-E-S.	
24	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right.	
25	Thank you, Mr. James. Thank you, Mr. Johannes	

and thank you, Mr. Irani. All right. Are there 1 2 any preliminary matters that need to be brought 3 to the Board's attention? MS. YOHANNES: No, not at this time. 4 5 But we do hope to enter a Settlement Agreement 6 very soon. 7 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And as you know 8 Ms. Yohannes, the Board does look forward to 9 receiving Settlement Agreements because when we 10 receive Settlement Agreements, it informs the 11 Board that the parties are able to work this out 12 to their mutual satisfaction and that the Board 13 does not have to get involved to make one side 14 mad at them. 15 I don't want the community or our 16 licensee mad at the Board. So I prefer when 17 folks have a Settlement Agreement and so everyone 18 can move on and be happy. And with Settlement 19 Agreements, then, I think that when there's a 20 meeting of the minds, most people can be happy. 21 So I'm glad we're settling. 22 MS. YOHANNES: Understood. 23 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. 24 other issues.

MR. JAMES: May I speak?

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Who is speaking, please?

MR. JAMES: Denis James, speaking for the Kalorama Citizens, I'm also hopeful that we can reach a Settlement Agreement. We initially sent a draft shortly after the establishment was placarded.

We had some discussions before Ms. Yohannes was hired. And since then she sent us a different draft then. We're going to get together on a conference call and talk about it soon.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. I'm glad to hear that. All right. Okay. The Board is unable to offer a date for a protest hearing at this juncture. But we will provide a date shortly for the new year. But I would -- the Board supports conversations between the parties to have a Settlement Agreement.

Are the parties familiar with the instructions for a protest hearing or do I need to read the instructions for a protest hearing to all three parties?

> MR. JAMES: No.

MR. IRANI: No. ANC 1C is familiar.
