| 23 | MS. JORDAN: There are no preliminary |
| 24 | matters at this time from the government. |
| 25 | CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Thank you. |

All right, then this matter is scheduled for a show cause hearing on December 14, 2022, at 10:30 a.m.

What that means, Mr. Gordon, is that since this matter is moving to a full hearing, seven days before the hearing, you are required if you're going to call any witnesses and if you have any documents you're going to rely on, you must provide copies of those documents and witnesses to Ms., to the government.

I don't know if this is Ms. Jordan's case, to the government seven days before, and then the government has to provide you a copy of those documents and witnesses seven days before also.

If the parties want to settle this matter, this matter can, they can have conversations and they could provide the board with a settlement offer if that's reached.

But that's where we are. Do you have any questions, sir?

MR. GORDON: So as of right now, we have, we don't talk about anything right now, this is just a show cause? So we don't -
