3 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: The next case
4 on our calendar is case number 19-CIT-00541,
5 Wicked Bloom, license number 103208. Ms.
6 Andrews, can you please elevate the rights of the
7 licensee, please?

8 MS. ANDREWS: Mr. Hines, your rights
9 have been elevated, and that's all, Mr. Chair.

10 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Thank you. All
11 right, good morning, everyone. Can we have the
12 parties introduce themselves for the record and
13 also spell out their names starting with the
14 government?

15 MR. ASIM: Good morning, Board
16 members, Shahzeb Asim and I represent the
17 District of Columbia. That's S-H-A-H-Z-E-B, last
18 name A-S-I-M.

19 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Thank you. Mr.
20 Hines?

21 MR. HINES: This is Melvin Hines,
22 first name Melvin, M-E-L-V-I-N, last name Hines,
23 H-I-N-E-S.

24 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And what's your
25 relationship to the establishment, sir?

1 MR. HINES: I am the owner of
2 Southeast Restaurant Group.

3 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right,
4 thank you. Mr. Asim, are there any preliminary
5 matters in this case?

6 MR. ASIM: Mr. Chairman, the parties
7 do not have an offer in compromise to present to
8 the Board at this time.

9 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Hines, are
10 there any preliminary matters you want to bring
11 to the Board's attention?

12 MR. HINES: I completed the report.
13 It may have been after the due date, which I
14 guess prompted the visit, but I have been in
15 compliance for both that period, as well as the
16 following period since then.

17 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right, you
18 and the government can discuss this case to see
19 whether or not this case is going to move
20 forward. However, this matter will be scheduled
21 for a show cause hearing at a date to be
22 determined in January.

23 I would ask both parties if they could
24 -- I'm not sure whose case this is from the
25 government, but I would ask that the government

1 contact the licensee, and if they are able to
2 settle this case through an OIC or we'll go to a
3 show cause hearing in January, all right? So,
4 thank you very much for your participation today
5 and have a great day.

6 MR. HINES: Thank you, sir.

7 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right.
