3 MS. FLETCHER: The next case on the  
4 calendar is the Dirty Goose, Case Number 22-PRO-  
5 00117, the Dirty Goose, LP, 913 U Street,  
6 Northwest, License Number ABRA-101299.

7 This is a Retailer Class CT License  
8 Renewal. The protest issues in this matter are  
9 adverse impact on peace, order, and quiet.

10 My name is LaVerne Fletcher,  
11 conducting the roll call hearing as the Board's  
12 agent. Is anyone present on behalf of the Dirty  
13 Goose?

14 MR. BIANCO: Good morning again, Ms.  
15 Fletcher. Richard Bianco for the Applicant. R-  
16 I-C-H-A-R-D B-I-A-N-C-O.

17 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you, Mr. Bianco.  
18 Anyone present on behalf of ANC? ANC 1B?

19 MR. BEHNA: This is Eric Behna present  
20 on behalf of ANC 1B. E-R-I-C B-E-H-N-A.

21 MS. FLETCHER: Behna. ANC 1B does  
22 have standing as a Protestant. We need to set a  
23 date for a status hearing, a protest hearing, and  
24 medication.

12 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. I just

14 to the first week in January?

15 Or is anybody available the week of  
16 December 26?

17 MR. BIANCO: I'm available the week of  
18 December 26, if everybody else can make that  
19 work.

20 MS. FLETCHER: Okay.

21 MR. BEHNA: That can work for the ANC.

22 MS. FLETCHER: That does work Mr.

23 Behna?

24 MR. BEHNA: That's correct.

25 MS. FLETCHER: Oh, okay. Then how

1 about Wednesday, December 28 at 10:00 a.m.?

2 MR. BIANCO: That works for us.

3 MR. BEHNA: That works for us.

4 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Then the  
5 mediation is set for 10:00 on December 28. Thank  
6 you for coming.

7 MR. BIANCO: Thank you very much.
