MS. FLETCHER: The next case on the calendar is Mama 'San/Harlot. This is Case Number 22-PRO-00122, Nicolas Hospitality, Inc., 2001 11th Street, Northwest, License Number ABRA114205.

This is a Retailer Class CT License Renewal. The protest issues are adverse impact on peace, order, and quiet.

My name is LaVerne Fletcher, conducting the roll call hearing as the Board's agent. Anyone present on behalf of Mama
'San/Harlot?
MR. BAILEY: David Bailey, authorized agent. Common spelling of first name, D-A-V-I-D. Last name, $B-$ as in boy, A- as in apple, I- as in igloo, L- as in Larry, E- as in Edward, Y- as in yo-you.

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you, Mr. Bailey. Is anyone else present?

MR. KALANTAR: Good morning, Ms.
Fletcher. My name is Alain Kalantar. A- as in apple, L- as in Larry, A- as in apple, I- as in Irene, like Nancy. Last name, K- as in Karen,

MS. FLETCHER: Excuse me. I'm sorry, Mr. Kalantar. I'm sorry to interrupt. I heard some background noise.

So, I wasn't able to hear you. Can you repeat that one more time?

MR. KALANTAR: First name, Alain, A-L-A-I-N.

as well? This is Alain Kalantar.
MS. FLETCHER: And who's -- who's speaking so the court reporter can know?

MR. KALANTAR: This is Alain Kalantar. I do have a custody case in the month of January. So, for me as well, if you could possibly find a date in December, that would be very helpful.

Thank you very much.
MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Let's see. One second here. What about December 16, at 10:00? Or December 22, at 2:00?
