3	MS. FLETCHER: Here on behalf of
4	Tawle?
5	MR. SAULT: That's correct.
6	MS. FLETCHER: Is that the correct
7	pronunciation? Is it Tawle? Tawle?
8	MR. SAULT: Yes, it's Tawle.
9	MS. FLETCHER: It's Tawle, okay.
10	Thank you very much. Anyone else present from
11	the group of 20?
12	MR. BARZILAI: Ms. Fletcher, this is
13	Yaniv Barzilai. I just wanted to add, if you
14	looked at the chat, that there is an abutting
15	neighbor who has just joined the group protest
16	and has filed a separate protest as abutting
17	neighbor.
18	And, has is both present and listed
19	in that chat. I can read the message if that's
20	helpful.
21	MS. RINGUETTE: Hi. I'm so sorry.
22	We're in the middle of a doctor's appointment
23	right now.
24	But, you have Michelle and David
25	Ringuette.

1	MS. FLETCHER: Excuse me. Michelle,
2	can you mute yourself?
3	MS. RINGUETTE: I'm trying to tell you
4	on the abutting neighbor.
5	MS. FLETCHER: Well, that particular
6	
7	MS. RINGUETTE: And that we're both
8	here.
9	MS. FLETCHER: Okay, just a second.
10	Hold on one minute. You're the abutting neighbor
11	in the matter of Tawle?
12	MS. RINGUETTE: Yes.
13	MS. FLETCHER: So, can you state your
14	name and spell it one more time?
15	MS. RINGUETTE: My name is Michelle
16	Ringuette. I'm here with my husband David Price.
17	You can spell it, M-I-C-H-E-L-L-E, last name R-I-
18	N-G-U-E-T-T-E.
19	MS. FLETCHER: Okay. And your your
20	husband's first name is David?
21	MS. RINGUETTE: D-A-V-I-D, last name,
22	P-R-I-C-E. And, we are part of the group
23	protesting.
24	MS. FLETCHER: And Ms. Ringuette, can
25	you spell your husband's la

1	MS. RINGUETTE: And, we are also the
2	abutting neighbors.
3	MS. FLETCHER: Can you spell your
4	husband's last name one more time?
5	MS. RINGUETTE: P-R-I-C-E.
6	MS. FLETCHER: Oh, okay. Thank you.
7	And you okay, you both signed the
8	MS. RINGUETTE: Yes. We signed the
9	neighborhood protest letter. And, we've also
10	submitted our own because of our experiences
11	living near there.
12	MS. FLETCHER: Okay. And so, you
13	filed as a part of the group and separately as
14	abutting property owners?
15	MS. RINGUETTE: Yes.
16	MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Anyone else from
17	the group?
18	(No response.)
19	MS. FLETCHER: So, we have ANC 1B does
20	have standing as a Protestant. I count eight is
21	present from the group of 20.
22	Which means that at least five members
23	from the group are present today. And the group
24	is granted full standing as a Protestant.
25	We need to set a date for a status

1 hearing, a protest hearing, and a mediation. 2 I'll give you the dates for the status and 3 protest hearing first. The status hearing is set for January 4 5 11, 2023, at 10:30, January 11. The protest hearing is set for February 1, 2023, at 1:30. 6 7 We need to set a date for mediation. 8 I'll give you the next day available. Only the 9 designated representatives for the group of 20 10 need appear for the mediation, either both or 11 either one. 12 And, of course, any other members of 13 the group are welcomed to attend as well. T'11 14 give you the next date available for mediation. 15 The next date available is Tuesday, 16 December 20. 17 MR. BARZILAI: Ms. Fletcher, this is 18 Yaniv Barzilai, I'm one of the representatives. 19 I unfortunately, will be out of town that entire 20 week. 21 MS. FLETCHER: Okay. 22 MR. BARZILAI: If we can do it another 23 time, --24 We can. MS. FLETCHER: 25 MR. BARZILAI: That would be -- yes,

-	chain you.
2	MS. FLETCHER: So, we can do it we
3	can do it December 27 or December actually
4	December 27 is going to be the only other day in
5	December.
6	MR. BARZILAI: Can we pause maybe?
7	MS. FLETCHER: Otherwise, we
8	MR. BARZILAI: This is Yaniv again.
9	Let me just pause and make sure that everybody
10	else is okay with that. That works for me.
11	MR. BEHNA: That works for the ANC.
12	MS. FLETCHER: That works for the ANC?
13	That was December 27.
14	MR. BEHNA: At what time?
15	MS. FLETCHER: Any time between 10:00
16	and 1:30. Okay.
17	MR. BEHNA: I would prefer the
18	earliest one, if other folks
19	MS. FLETCHER: Mr. Behna, is that you
20	speaking?
21	MR. BEHNA: Early morning.
22	MS. FLETCHER: Mr. Behna, is that you
23	speaking for the ANC?
24	MR. BEHNA: Yes. The ANC would prefer
25	the 10:00 a.m. if possible, on the 27th.

1	MS. FLETCHER: Okay.
2	MR. BARZILAI: This is Yaniv. I have
3	no preference on time. That's certainly fine.
4	MS. FLETCHER: Is that okay for Brian
5	Parker as well?
6	MR. PARKER: Ms. Fletcher, I will say
7	I I, the Applicant, I am not available on
8	I'm not available until 11:00 on the 27th.
9	MS. FLETCHER: That's okay on this end
10	if it's okay with everybody else.
11	MR. BEHNA: That's fine.
12	MR. BARZILAI: This is Yaniv. That's
13	fine with me as well.
14	MS. FLETCHER: That's fine with Mr.
15	Behna and ANC, and the ANC. Okay. I'm just
16	trying to help the court reporter to keep
17	everything straight. Thank you.
18	MR. PARKER: This is Brian Parker.
19	That works for me as well.
20	MS. FLETCHER: And Yaniv, does that
21	work for you as well?
22	MR. BARZILAI: It does. Thank you
23	very much.
24	MS. FLETCHER: Okay. So, mediation is
25	set for Tuesday, December 27 at 11:00. Okay.

1	MS. YOHANNES: And that's fine. Can
2	I can I get some clarification before we, we
3	conclude this?
4	In terms of the Protestants and
5	MS. FLETCHER: Excuse me. Ms.
6	Yohannes, I'm just letting the court reporter
7	know who's speaking.
8	Go ahead.
9	MS. YOHANNES: Okay, yes. I just want
10	to confirm, we only have a group of five or more
11	in the ANC as Protestants together.
12	Is that correct?
13	MS. FLETCHER: Yes.
14	MS. YOHANNES: Okay.
15	MS. FLETCHER: Yes, ma'am.
16	MR. BARZILAI: Ms. Fletcher, this is
17	Yaniv. I just want to confirm, there is another
18	Protestant, an abutting neighbor Protestant that
19	is by Michelle.
20	MS. FLETCHER: You mean by by
21	Michelle Ringuette?
22	MR. BARZILAI: Correct.
23	MS. FLETCHER: And so, I included Ms.
24	Ringuette as a part of your group. She mentioned
25	she filed as a part of your group and as an

	abutting property owner?
2	MR. BARZILAI: Correct. She has
3	she joined our group. But, she has standing as
4	an abutting property owner that is separate and
5	distinct.
6	MS. FLETCHER: Yes. Yes, I just
7	yeah, I was just letting Ms. Yohannes know that
8	about the group.
9	So, there is the ANC 1B. There is the
10	group of 20, of which Ms. Ringuette is a part of.
11	And, she filed a protest as an abutting property
12	owner as well, which means that she has a
13	standalone protest as well.
14	MS. YOHANNES: And, we've not received
15	that protest that was filed.
16	MS. FLETCHER: From Ms. Ringuette?
17	MS. YOHANNES: Correct.
18	MS. FLETCHER: Ms. Ringuette
19	MS. YOHANNES: Has the Agency received
20	that? I mean, I presume so since she just
21	indicated so.
22	But, we have not received it. And,
23	can we get confirmation on when this was filed?
24	MS. FLETCHER: Well, let me see what
25	I can find out right now. Just give me one

1	second please.
2	MS. YOHANNES: Okay.
3	MS. FLETCHER: So, while I'm looking,
4	Ms. Ringuette, can you tell me if you've received
5	a letter acknowledging receipt of your protest
6	from our Assistant General Counsel?
7	(No response.)
8	MR. TRUONG: She's this is Joseph
9	Truong speaking, since she's at the doctor right
10	now.
11	I can just mention that she had sent
12	the email to ABRA Legal on November 13, 2022, at
13	6:08 p.m.
14	MS. FLETCHER: Let me write that down.
15	Thank you. That was November?
16	MR. TRUONG: 13th.
17	MS. FLETCHER: 13.
18	MR. TRUONG: 2022 at 6:08 p.m.
19	MS. FLETCHER: To ABRA Legal?
20	MR. TRUONG: Yes.
21	MS FLETCHER: Thank you.
22	MR. TRUONG: And, she also yep.
23	So, she sent it to ABRA Legal. I can't confirm
24	though when she's received her, her confirmation,
25	et cetera.

So, she'll have to confirm that with 1 2 you directly. 3 MS. FLETCHER: That's okay. I will -that's okay. I will -- Ms. Yohannes, I will look 4 5 into that and get back with you post-roll call. I'm going to check and make sure that 6 7 the -- that Ms. Ringuette received her letter of 8 receipt for her protest. One second. 9 So, her name is on the list that I 10 have for the group of 20. There were some names 11 on that list that weren't legible. 12 And, I received an email from the 13 designated representative from the group to spell 14 the names of the individuals on the list. And, 15 Ms. Ringuette's name is on that list. 16 So, her name may be one of those that 17 But, I'll are not legible on the protest letter. 18 straighten all that out after roll call, Ms. 19 Yohannes. And I'll get back to you. 20 MS. YOHANNES: Thank you. 21 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you. For the 22 purpose of the roll call hearing, I'm going to 23 count Ms. Ringuette as a part of the group of 20. 24 I will confirm receipt of her protest alleging to

be an abutting property owner.

1 But, for the purpose of the roll call hearing, I'm going to grant standing to the group 2 3 of 20 and to Ms. Ringuette as an abutting property owner. If that turns out not to be the 4 5 case, then we'll take care of it at a later time. 6 I have mediation scheduled for 7 Tuesday, December 27, at 11:00. And you'll receive the WebEx invitations to attend. 8 9 Any questions from anybody? 10 (No response.) 11 MS. FLETCHER: Well, thank you for 12 coming.
