CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning.

As Chairperson of the Alcoholic Beverage Control

Board for the District of Columbia and in

accordance with D.C. Code Section 2571 et seq. of

the Open Meetings Act, OMA, I am welcoming you to

the regularly scheduled meeting of the Alcoholic

Beverage Control Board.

This meeting is being conducted pursuant to guidance made available by the District of Columbia's Office of Open Government regarding electronic meetings held by public bodies. Electronic meetings by the ABC Board are authorized pursuant to Section 2577(a) of the D.C. Code.

Pursuant to the OMA requirements, notice of today's meeting was provided 48 hours in advance of the meeting on ABRA's website and on the District's central meeting calendar. The notice included the time, date, agenda, and the call-in or log-in information for public participation.

I would like to introduce the other members of the ABC Board who are also 6 7 participating electronically. Please respond 8 when I announce your name. Mr. James Short? 9 MEMBER SHORT: Mr. James Short, 10 present. CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Bobby Cato? 11 12 MEMBER CATO: Bobby Cato, present. CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Jeni 13 Hansen? Mr. Edward Grandis? 14 15 MEMBER GRANDIS: Edward Grandis, 16 present. CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: 17 The Board has five members in attendance for the conduct of 18 business today and that constitutes a quorum. 19 Before we get underway with today's 20 hearing calendar, I need to make a few 21 2.2 instructions very clear so that the conduct of 23 this hearing is understood by everyone. There are four cases scheduled for this morning's 24 calendar. 25

Once your case is called, I will take a moment for our IT specialist to elevate the rights for each party to enable their camera and microphone. Then, and only then, will you have the ability to enable your equipment. If your case is not being heard, you will remain mute and your camera will be disabled.

At the conclusion of each case, the parties will have the option to leave. If the party chooses to stay, all cameras and microphones for the concluded case will be disabled.

Should you have any questions or require technical assistance during the hearing, please submit them using the question and answer feature.

Give me a minute, please. I need to make sure that they -- I need to make sure the court reporter is on because I'm doing this hearing virtual and I just want to make sure that this is being recorded. Okay, yes, the court reporter is on.

All right, our first order -- our first case today is case number 22 -- it's a show cause hearing status case number 22-CMP-00063,

case Death Punch/Shabu/Shibuya Eatery, license 1 number 114937. 2 Good morning, Mr. Orellana. Can you 3 please elevate the rights of the government and 4 the licensee in this case, please? 5 MR. ORELLANA: Collin Cenci, your 6 7 access has been elevated. Lyle Blanchard, your access has been elevated. That is all, Chairman. 8 9 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Thank you. Okay, good morning, Mr. Cenci. Can you please 10 11 spell and state your name for the record, please? 12 MR. CENCI: Good morning, Chairperson Collin Cenci, C-O-L-L-I-N C-E-N-C-I, 13 Anderson. Assistant Attorney General with the Office of the 14 Attorney General for the District of Columbia. 15 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right, good 16 17 morning, Mr. Blanchard. Can you please spell and state your name for the record? 18 19 MR. BLANCHARD: Good morning, Mr. Anderson and Members of the ABC Board. 20 21 is Lyle Blanchard, B, sorry, first name is L-Y-L-2.2 E, last name is B-L-A-N-C-H-A-R-D, and I'm representing the licensee which is Iron Works, 23 LLC trading as Death Punch, et cetera. 24 25 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning.

All right, Mr. Cenci, is there any preliminary 1 matters in this case? 2 MR. CENCI: None from the government 3 at this time, Mr. Chairperson. 4 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right, this 5 hearing then, on behalf of the government, this 6 matter then is scheduled for a show cause hearing 7 on January 11, 2023 at 10:30 a.m. 8 9 I just want to advise the parties if this matter is not settled, then since I'm 10 11 working with two attorneys, that you are required 12 seven days prior to the hearing to disclose documents and witnesses that will be relied upon 13 at the hearing. 14 15 Failure on the part of either party to 16 disclose documents and witnesses that will be relied upon at the hearing, unless good cause is 17 shown, the Board is empowered to prevent that 18 person from relying on documents and witnesses 19 that have not been previously disclosed. 20 21 questions by anyone? 2.2 MR. BLANCHARD: No questions, Your 23 Honor. I don't know if I could make a short 24 statement? 25 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Only if it's

procedural, sir. 1 MR. BLANCHARD: Oh, well, just to say 2 that I did have a conversation with Mister, one 3 of OAG's attorneys yesterday, so we have begun 4 5 discussions and we'll see if anything evolves 6 between now and the hearing date. 7 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Well, thank The parties are directed then if this 8 you. 9 matter is settled, then they can provide us the terms, the written terms, and the Board will 10 11 review and vote to approve or deny it on our 12 legal agenda. So, if the matter is settled, we don't need to have another hearing. It can be 13 done through paper. 14 15 MR. BLANCHARD: Understood. CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: 16 17 MR. BLANCHARD: Thank you. CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right, if 18 -- thank you very much for being here today and 19 have a great day. 20 21 MR. BLANCHARD: You too. Thank you. 22 MR. CENCI: Thank you, Mr. 23 Chairperson.
