10	MR. ADAMS: Yes, Mr. Chairman. Walter
11	Adams representing the District of Columbia.
12	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Hirao, can
13	you please identify yourself for the record,
14	please?
15	MS. HIRAO: Yes, Risa Hirao, H-I-R-A-
16	O. I'm representing the licensee.
17	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Thank you. All
18	right. Mr. Adams, are there any preliminary
19	matters in this case?
20	MR. ADAMS: Yes, there is, Mr.
21	Chairman. The parties have discussed a
22	settlement of this case and are in the position
23	to offer to propose an offer in compromise to
24	the Board.
25	CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And what is the

offer in compromise, please?

MR. ADAMS: Yes, Mr. Chairman. There is a single charge in this case for alleging the establishment's failure to properly transport alcoholic beverages in the vehicle which is a secondary tier offense. For that case, we are -- the parties agreed to a fine in the amount of 250 dollars to be paid in 90 days. And if the establishment fails to make that payment for that period, their license shall be suspended indefinitely until the fine is paid.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Thank you. All right. Ms. Hirao, it's my understanding there's an offer in compromise, and the offer in compromise is that there is a fine of 250 dollars paid within 90 days. If the fine is not paid within 90 days, the license will be suspended until the fine has been paid. Is this your client's understanding of -- you and your client's understanding of the offer in compromise?

MS. HIRAO: Yes.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Is your client aware that by accepting an offer in compromise, they're giving up their right to a hearing?

1 MS. HIRAO: Yes. 2 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Is your client 3 also aware that by accepting an offer in 4 compromise that they're giving up their right to 5 appeal this matter? MS. HIRAO: Yes. 6 7 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. With that said, I make a motion that the offer in 8 9 compromise of a fine of 250 dollars paid within 10 90 days be accepted. If the fine is not payable 11 within 90 days, the license will be suspended 12 indefinitely until the fine has been paid. there a second? 13 14 MEMBER CROCKETT: Ms. Crockett 15 seconds. 16 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Crockett 17 has second the motion. We'll now have a roll 18 call on a motion that has been properly second by 19 Ms. Crockett. Mr. Short? 20 MEMBER SHORT: Mr. Short, I agree. 21 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Cato? 22 MEMBER CATO: Bobby Cato, I agree. 23 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Crockett? 24 MEMBER CROCKETT: Rafi Crockett, I
