And again, I 5 apologize, we've had an update in Webex, and have had some connectivity issues this morning, but 6 7 we're all here now, thank you. My name is LaVerne Fletcher, and I'll be conducting the roll 8 9 call hearings as the board's agent this morning. 10 There are two cases on the calendar, 11 the first case -- before I get started, Ms. 12 Mahmoud, and Ms. Edwards, can you hear me? 13 MS. EDWARDS: I can, yes. 14 MS. MAHMOUD: Yes, I can. 15 MS. FLETCHER: And can the court 16 reporter hear me too? 17 Yes, I can. COURT REPORTER: 18 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you very much. 19 Mr. Hyman, I know you're having some issues with 20 you being able to hear me, but I can hear you. 21 If you have any questions you can just put them 2.2 in the chat, okay? Thank you. The first case on 23 the calendar is Gray's Market, this is case

number 23-PRO-00092, MEG & AN, LLC., 3306 Georgia

Avenue Northwest, license number ABRA 120092.

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This is a retailer class B grocery store, this I a license renewal, and the protest issues are adverse impact on peace, order, and quiet, real property values, and pedestrian safety. My name is LaVerne Fletcher, conducting the roll call hearing as the board's agent. Is there anyone present on behalf of Gray's Market?

Is there anyone present on behalf of MD Homes? Mr. Hyman, you're present? Mr. Hyman, I'm going to -- I see you, I'm going to state your name for the record, and spell it for the record. Mr. Hyman is present on behalf of MD Homes. Mr. Hyman's name is spelled M-A-R-C, the middle initial is A, the last name is spelled H-Y-M-A-N.

Mr. Hyman, can you clarify something for me? You're representing MD Homes as the abutting property owner, or are you the abutting property owner? You are the abutting property owner? Okay, thank you, Mr. Hyman. You're the sole owner of the LLC., and the LLC., is that 3302 Georgia Avenue, LLC.? Okay, thank you. And so, that also includes 3304 Georgia Avenue Northwest, the LLC. includes both?

Thank you. Mr. Hyman said that is

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correct. Mr. Hyman, those two locations are abutting property owners according to the D.C. Geographic Information System. And just to clarify for the record, the addresses of 3302 Georgia Avenue Northwest, and 3304 Georgia Avenue Northwest, those two addresses are abutting property owners.

Which means that Mr. Hyman, the LLC. has standing as a protestant. The time is approximately 10:35, and there is no one present on behalf of Gray's Market. Therefore the license renewal application is dismissed. What that means, Mr. Hyman, is that the board will issue an order dismissing the application. And upon receipt of the order, the applicant will have ten days to seek reinstatement of the application with an explanation for why they're not present today.

You'll receive a copy of the order, and you'll also have an opportunity to respond to their request to reinstate. And do you have any questions related to what happens next, Mr.

Hyman? Mr. Hyman, are you sending me a message in the chat? Ttake your time, I'm waiting. Okay, I see it now. So, Mr. Hyman's question is so then

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will this roll call meeting happen a second time should Gray's Market wish to reinstate?

No, Mr. Hyman, the roll call hearing will not happen a second time. You're being granted standing as a protestant today, so that's one thing that was supposed to happen today. So, the next thing that will happen is the board reinstates the application, is that I will contact you, provide you with dates for a mediation, a status hearing, and a protest hearing, because those are the things that happen next after the roll call.

So, if they reinstate, I'll contact you to just put the case back on track. But you've already been granted standing as a protestant, so there won't be any need for a second roll call hearing. Mr. Hyman is saying okay to that, that's very good, and he understands. Right, Mr. Hyman?

Okay, thank you very much, Mr. Hyman, for coming. You're welcome to log off now, this roll call hearing is concluded, or you're welcome to stay, but this case is concluded.
