The Alcoholic Beverage Control Board met via WebEx videoconference, LaVerne Fletcher, Board's Agent, presiding.

MS. FLETCHER: The next case on the calendar is The Fireplace. This is case number 22-PRO-00149. The Fireplace Restaurant, Inc., t/a The Fireplace 2161 P Street, NW. License number ABRA 014419. This is a Retailer Class CT license renewal.

The protest issues are adverse impact on peace, order and quiet.

My name is LaVerne Fletcher conducting the roll call hearing as the Board's agent. Is anyone present on behalf of the establishment?

MR. GRISWELL: Yes, Ms. Fletcher, this Jeremiah Griswell and I'm here as a representative for The Fireplace.

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you, Mr. --
MR. GRISWELL: Griswell.
MS. FLETCHER: Griswell?
MR. GRISWELL: Griswell.
MS. FLETCHER: Yes, I received your email this morning, thank you. Could you spell your name for the record?

MR. GRISWELL: Sure, it's G-R-I-S-W-E-L-L.

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you. Is anyone else present for the establishment?

MR. GRISWELL: I don't believe so. I believe it's just me.

MS. FLETCHER: Is anyone present on behalf of ANC 2B?

MR. RUECKGAUER: Jeff Rueckgauer.
MS. FLETCHER: Could you spell that for the record, please?

MR. RUECKGAUER: Yes, it's J-E-F-F last name R-U-E-C-K-G-A-U-E-R and I am the Commissioner for Single Member District 2B02, where The Fireplace is located.

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you, Mr. Rueckgauer. ANC 2B is the only protestant in this matter and does have standing as a protestant. We need to set a date for a status hearing, a protest hearing and a mediation.

I'll give you the date for the status hearing first. The status hearing is set for February 8, 2023 at 10:30 a.m. The protest hearing is set for March 15, 2023 at 1:30 p.m.

I'll give you the next available day for mediation. The next available day if you want to come the first week of January, January 4
is available or we can move to the following week. Does anybody want (Simultaneous speaking.)

MR. RUECKGAUER: Yeah, I would request the following week since the first week we're just sworn in again.

MS. FLETCHER: Yes, oh that's right. What about Wednesday, January -- did you say the following week?

MR. RUECKGAUER: Yeah, the following, the second week.

MS. FLETCHER: Okay, the second week. What about Tuesday, January oh no, that's not going to be good, that's a holiday. We can do Tuesday, January 24 ?

MR. RUECKGAUER: Okay, that's fine.
MS. FLETCHER: We can do any time between 10 and 1:30.

MR. RUECKGAUER: How about 1:30?
MS. FLETCHER: 1:30, okay. Does that work for you, Mr. Griswell?

MR. GRISWELL: It does. I'm a little confused because, however, I believe the ANC and myself we've been discussing this and we're almost at a head. I just want to make sure that should we resolve the matter that these dates
would be written off the calendar?
MS. FLETCHER: That's exactly right, that's what happens. If the matter is resolved, all of these dates come off the calendar. If the matter is resolved before January 24, the mediation also comes off of the calendar.

MR. GRISWELL: Okay, so there's no problems with any of those dates. If I can just get them again because $I$ was just adding them to my phone.

MS. FLETCHER: Okay. The dates are for The Fireplace status hearing is February 8 at 10:30 a.m., that's February 8. The protest hearing is March 15, 2023 at 1:30 and the mediation is January 24 at 1:30.

MR. GRISWELL: Okay, those are not any problem whatsoever and we'll also receive an email just in case $I$ didn't get those down correctly?

MS. FLETCHER: Mr. Rueckgauer, is that you? Oh, Mr. Griswell, what did you say again?

MR. GRISWELL: I said I got those dates, $I$ just want to make sure that $I$ have them correctly, so we'll receive an e-mail with those dates?

MS. FLETCHER: You're going to receive a Webex invitation.

MR. GRISWELL: Perfect.
MS. FLETCHER: Yes. So, I'll send you the Webex invitation for mediation and you'll receive a Webex invitation for the status and protest hearings from another member of the staff.

MR. GRISWELL: Okay, sounds fantastic.
MS. FLETCHER: Okay, anything else?
MR. RUECKGAUER: Yes, Ms. Fletcher. I just wanted to inquire about how would we consolidate the existing protest for the 2019 renewal?

MS. FLETCHER: So, if you want to actually -- so, a couple of things. If you want to consolidate the cases or you want to consolidate the settlement agreement, there are a couple of things. Let me just tell you the couple ways to do that, Mr. Rueckgauer. If you want to combine the cases, you mean the case from 2019?

MR. RUECKGAUER: Yes.
MS. FLETCHER: So, if you want to combine the case from 2019 and the case for
today, you would need to file a motion with the Board to lift a stay. The case from 2019 has presently been stayed, I guess you know that already, yes?

MR. RUECKGAUER: Yes, ma'am.
MS. FLETCHER: Oh, so the first thing that you would need to do would be to file a motion to lift the stay, that's number one if you want to combine the cases. So, that's the first step. Then the next step would be to file a motion to combine the cases, so first lift the stay then combine. That's a two-step process if you want to do that.

MR. RUECKGAUER: Okay and so
(Simultaneous speaking.) and for doing that, do I need to have the group of five plus the DCCA signing on that or can the ANC request that alone?

MS. FLETCHER: I don't have the 2019 case in front of me, so there's more than protestant in this case?

MR. RUECKGAUER: Yes, the ANC, Dupont Circle Citizens Association and the group of five or more residents.

MS. FLETCHER: Do you know if they're
all interested in lifting the stay or no?
MR. RUECKGAUER: Yes, everyone's on board with doing this.

MS. FLETCHER: Well then yeah, it can just be a joint motion.

MR. RUECKGAUER: Okay.
MS. FLETCHER: Everybody would just sign that motion.

MR. RUECKGAUER: Right and who do we address that to?

MS. FLETCHER: The ABC Board.
MR. RUECKGAUER: ABC Board.
MS. FLETCHER: You can address to the ABC Board and e-mail it to Martha Jenkins.

MR. RUECKGAUER: Right, okay.
MS. FLETCHER: The other thing, Mr. Rueckgauer, just so that you know, if this matter is resolved during mediation, you may also resolve the 2019 protest at the same time. If you would like to do that, but in the settlement agreement you would have to say that you're resolving the 2019 case and the 2022 case. I just wanted to tell you about that option as well.

MR. RUECKGAUER: Okay, whichever is
the easiest one for everybody is the one we want to go with.

MS. FLETCHER: It'll probably be easiest for you if you reach an agreement, if you just close the 2019 case out in the 2022 agreement. You would just need the 2019 case number. Do you have that?

MR. RUECKGAUER: I believe we do.
MS. FLETCHER: Okay, if you don't, you can -- I have it right here. I'll give it to you just in case.

MR. RUECKGAUER: Okay. All righty.
MS. FLETCHER: Okay, the 2019 case number is 19-PRO-00140.

MR. RUECKGAUER: And that was $P$ as in
Peter or T as in Thomas?
MS. FLETCHER: Oh, $P$ as in Peter.
Peter as in Peter --
MR. RUECKGAUER: Okay.
MS. FLETCHER: R-0 19-PRO-00140.
MR. RUECKGAUER: Okay, great. Thank you very much.

MS. FLETCHER: Okay, so then all right, I'll see you on the 24th and we'll see what happens.

MR. RUECKGAUER: Okay.
MS. FLETCHER: Thank you very much for coming.

MR. RUECKGAUER: Thank you very much.
MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Anything, Mr. Griswell?

MR. GRISWELL: No, I believe that answers all my questions.

MS. FLETCHER: Okay, well thank you for coming. The roll call hearing in the matter of The Fireplace is closed.
