3 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Let's now do
4 our legal agenda. The first matter on our legal
5 agenda is a review of an Offer in Compromise in
6 lieu of a hearing dated December 6, 2023 for Case
7 No. 23-6 -- I'm sorry, 23-CMP-00063. This is
8 3321 Bistro DC Restaurant, License No. 117625.

9 The Offer in Compromise is as follows:
10 Charge 1, provided false statement, statutory
11 authority, D.C. Code Section 25-823(a)(5) .

12 There's a fine of 1,000 dollars payable within 30
13 days or the license shall be suspended
14 indefinitely until the fine has been paid.

15 Charge No. 2, tampered with evidence, statutory
16 authority, D.C. Code Section 25-823(a)(10).

17 There's a fine of 1,000 dollars
18 payable within 30 days or the license shall be
19 suspended indefinitely until the fine has been
20 paid. Charge No. 3, interfered with an
21 investigation by destroying or concealing
22 evidence, statutory authority, D.C. Code Section
23 25-823(a)(5)(D). That charge is dismissed.

24 Charge No. 4, interfered with an
25 investigation by refusing to allow the

1 examination of the licensee's books and records,
2 statutory authority, D.C. Code Section 25-
3 823(a)(5)(B). That charge has also been
4 dismissed. Charge 5, interfered with an
5 investigation by failing to produce requested
6 documentation of record within 48 hours,
7 statutory authority, D.C. Code Section 25-
8 823(a)(5)(E).

9 For this charge, there's a fine of
10 1,000 paid within 30 days or the license shall be
11 suspended indefinitely until the fine has been
12 paid. I therefore make a motion that the Offer
13 in Compromise be accepted. Is there a second?

14 MEMBER SHORT: Mr. Short, I second.

15 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Short has
16 second the motion. We'll have a roll call vote.
17 Mr. Short?

5 performance at a dance place. This is December
6 16th and December 17th. License number is
7 127098, 200 attendees, 4 security guards.

8 No. 7, another request by Andre
9 Mazelin, a one-day license Class G, live
10 performance, December 15, License No. 127099, 200
11 attendees, 4 security guards. No. 8, a request
12 for Tilaro, T-I-L-A-R-I-O, Best, a one-day
13 license Class G, family and friends fall
14 gathering. This is December 16th. The license
15 number is 127097, 70 attendees, 4 security
16 guards.

17 No. 9, a request from Tony & Joe's
18 Seafood Place, one-day substantial change, New
19 Year's Eve party. Nature of substantial change:
20 utilize a common space between Tony & Joe's and
21 Nick's Riverside Grille. This is December 31st.
22 The license number is 010762. The substantial
23 change license is 23-SC-01246.

24 No. 10, request from RegMoPromo
25 Holdings, a pub crawl, The Bourbon to U Street

1 Crawl. This is on -- I'm sorry. This is
2 February 10th, 2024, maximum of 1,000 parties for
3 this event. The license number is 104072. The
4 substantial change is 23-PCE-00029.

5 No. 11, another request from
6 RegMoPromo Holdings, a pub crawl, The Lucky U
7 Street Bar Crawl. This is March 16, 2024. The
8 license number is 104072. Substantial change
9 license, 23-PCE-00030. Again, this is an event
10 that the maximum capacity is 1,000 that we're
11 recommending.

16 We are approving a maximum of 1,500 for this
17 event.

20 February 10th, 2024. License number is 105182.
21 Substantial change license, 23-PCE-00035. We are
22 approving 1,500 as a maximum number for this
23 event.

24 No. 14, Project DC Events, The
25 Shamrock Crawl 2024, March 16th, 2024. License

1 number is 105182. The substantial change
2 license, 23-PCE-00036. We are approving -- we
3 conditional approved for 1,000 for this event.

4 And No. 15 was a request from Michael
5 Amatangelo, A-M-A-T-A-N-G-E-L-O, for a one-day
6 license Class F, the U.S. Navy Command Holiday
7 Party. This was on December 8th, 2023. The
8 license number is 127061, 200 attendees, 4
9 security guards. I therefore make a motion that
10 the ABC Board approve of these license requests.
11 Is there a second?

12 MEMBER GRANT: Mr. Grant, I second the
13 motion.

14 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Grant has
15 second the motion. We'll now have a roll call
16 vote. Mr. Short?

17 MEMBER SHORT: Mr. Short, I agree.

18 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Grant?

19 MEMBER GRANT: Mr. Grant, I agree.

20 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And Mr.
21 Anderson, I agree. The matter passed 3-0. We
22 now move to the Board's license administrative

1 all 18 request be approved. Is there a second?

2 MEMBER GRANT: Mr. Grant, I second the
3 motion.

4 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Grant has
5 second the motion. We'll have a roll call vote.
6 Mr. Short?

7 MEMBER SHORT: Mr. Short, I agree.

8 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Grant?

9 MEMBER GRANT: Mr. Grant, I agree.

10 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And Mr.
11 Anderson, I agree. The matter passed 3-0. And
12 we now move to our final agenda for the morning.
13 It's the medical cannabis licensing agenda. The
14 first matter on our medical cannabis licensing
15 agenda, the first, it's a conditional cultivation
16 center application.

17 So the first -- I am going to read all
18 of the applications and with the recommendations.
19 And at the end of the list, I will ask the Board
20 to approve the recommendations that were made by
21 the Board -- I'm sorry, by the chair. And so I'm
22 going to ask for an approval of the
23 recommendations by the chair for these licenses.

24 So the first one is review of social
25 equity application for conditional cultivation

1 center license. This is for Bright Green LLC,
2 License No. 126775. I'm asking for an approval
3 for that one.

4 No. 2, review of standard application
5 for condition cultivation center license. This
6 is for Bear River Dispensaries, trade name, Bear
7 River Cannabis, License No. 126770. I'm asking
8 for approval.

9 Now we move to the social equity
10 retailer application, License No. 3. It's a
11 review of social equity application for new
12 retailer license with delivery endorsement. This
13 is for Wash Hydro, License No. 126952. The
14 recommendation by the chair is that this matter

3 facility and summer garden endorsement. This is
4 for Violet City, License No. 127008. The chair
5 recommends a fact finding.

6 No. 12, review of standard application
7 for new retailer license with delivery
8 endorsement. This is for Doobie District,
9 License No. 126751. The recommendation this
10 matter be -- this license be denied.

11 No. 13, review of standard license
12 application for new retailer license with
