The Alcoholic Beverage and Cannabis Board met via WebEx videoconference, LaVerne Fletcher, Board's Agent, presiding.

MS. FLETCHER: The next case on the calendar today is Nam's Market. This is case number 23-PRO-00098, Elharia, Inc., 1327 W Street Southeast, license number ABRA 111233. This is a retailer class $B$ beer and wine license. The protest issues are adverse impact on peace, order, and quiet. Is anyone present on behalf of Nam's Market? Is anyone present on behalf of Nam's Market?

MS. HUBBARD: I'm sorry, what's the market again?

MS. FLETCHER: It's Nam's, spelled, N-A-M-S Market.

MS. HUBBARD: Is that on Wheeler Road? That's not on Wheeler Road, is it?

MS. FLETCHER: No.
MS. HUBBARD: Okay.
MS. FLETCHER: So, who am I speaking with right now?

MS. HUBBARD: I'm sorry, my name is Lashawn Hubbard for Wheeler Market.

MS. FLETCHER: Okay, can you spell your name for the record please?

MS. HUBBARD: It's L-A-S as in Sam, H-A-W-N Hubbard, $\mathrm{H}-\mathrm{U}-\mathrm{B}$ as in boy, B as in boy, $\mathrm{A}-\mathrm{R}-$ D.

MS. FLETCHER: Ms. Hubbard, the Wheeler Market case has already been called, but in what capacity are you here today?

MS. HUBBARD: I didn't know, I thought it was at 10:00, okay, well I messed up the time for it.

MS. FLETCHER: I'm sorry, go ahead?
MS. HUBBARD: I'm sorry, I was testifying on behalf of Wheeler Market, I didn't know it was already over with.

MS. FLETCHER: It started about 10:00, today would not have been the day to testify. If the case goes forward for a protest hearing, the licensee can list you as a witness if the case gets to that point.

MS. HUBBARD: Okay, all right, thank you.

MS. FLETCHER: All right, so what I'm doing, this is for the court reporter's benefit. What I'm doing, I'm opening Wheeler Market for just a minute to allow Ms. Lashawn to be included on the record related to Wheeler Market. Okay,
well Ms. Hubbard, thank you for coming. As I said, this is not a time to testify, that will come at a protest hearing, but you're now on the record as being present.

MS. HUBBARD: Thank you so much.
MS. FLETCHER: You're welcome, have a good day.

MS. HUBBARD: You too.
MS. FLETCHER: Okay, bye bye.
MS. HUBBARD: Bye.
MS. FLETCHER: Okay. I'm returning to the matter of Nam's Market, giving the applicant another opportunity to say whether or not he's present. The time is approximately 10:20, the applicant is not present. The application for license renewal is dismissed. Is anyone present on behalf of the group of five or more?

MR. O'KEEFE: Yes, good morning, ma'am. My name is Patrick O'Keefe, spelled P-A-T-R-I-C-K, last name O'K-E-E-F-E, I'm the designated representative for the group of five in that case, and I'm joined on the line by five additional members of that group.

MS. FLETCHER: Okay, if each of those individuals would state their name and spell it
for the record please?
MS. JOHNSON: Yes, good morning, my name is --

MS. ROBERSON: Hi, this is --
MS. JOHNSON: My name is Traci
Johnson, and that's spelled T-R-A-C-I, last name J-O-H-N-S-O-N.

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you, Ms. Johnson, the next person?

MS. ROBERSON: Hi, this is Julia
Roberson, J-U-L-I-A R-O-B-E-R-S-O-N.
MS. FLETCHER: Thank you. Next person?

MR. SCHICHTEL: Good morning, this is Andrew Schichtel, A-N-D-R-E-W, last name S-C-H-I-C-H-T-E-L.

MS. FLETCHER: S-C-H-I?
MR. SCHICHTEL: C-H-T-E-L.
MS. FLETCHER: Thank you. Next person?

MS. MCGEE: Hi, this is Emily McGee, E-M-I-L-Y M-C-G-E-E. Thank you.

MR. MCGEE: And this is Daniel McGee, D-A-N-I-E-L M-C-G-E-E.

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you, Mr. McGee.

Anyone else? I count six individuals present today, which means that the group of 11 has standing as a protestant. Mr. O'Keefe?

MR. O'KEEFE: Yes, ma'am?
MS. FLETCHER: The applicant is not present today, and so the application for a license renewal was dismissed. The board will issue an order dismissing the application because the applicant is not present today. The applicant will have an opportunity to explain to the board the reason that they're not present today.

You will receive a copy of the board order. If the applicant seeks reinstatement of the application, you will have an opportunity to respond. You may be in agreement with the request to reinstate or you may not be, but you'll have an opportunity to respond.

MR. O'KEEFE: Okay, thank you, ma'am.
MS. FLETCHER: Any questions about
that?
MR. O'KEEFE: No, none at this time, thank you.

MS. FLETCHER: Okay, thank you very much. The matter of Nam's Market is concluded,
and Mr. O'Keefe, next case on the calendar is yours as well.
