MS. FLETCHER: The next case on the calendar is Flash. It's case number 22-PRO00112. Brilliant, LLC 645 Florida Avenue, NW, license number ABRA 090823. This is a Retailer Class CT license renewal. The protest issues are adverse impact on peace, order and quiet.

My name is LaVerne Fletcher conducting the Roll Call Hearing as the Board's agent.

Is anyone present on behalf of Flash?
MS. YOHANNES: Yes. Sidon Yohannes here on behalf of the licensee.

MR. MOTTAGHI: Afshin Mottaghi A-F-S-H-I-N last name M-O-T-T-A-G-H-I. I'm the licensee.

MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Can you state your name and spell it one more time for the record?

MR. MOTTAGHI: Sure, Afshin Mottaghi. First name is A-F-S-H-I-N last name M-O-T-T-A-G-H-I.

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you very much. Ms. Yohannes, would you spell your name for the record, please?

MS. YOHANNES: Oh yes, sure S-I-D-O-N Y-O-H-A-N-N-E-S.

MS. FLETCHER: Anyone present on behalf of ANC 1B?

MR. HANDERHAN: Yep, Larry Handerhan L-A-R-R-Y H-A-N-D-E-R-H-A-N, Commissioner for 1B01.

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you, Mr. Handerhan.

MR. HANDERHAN: Yep.
MS. FLETCHER: ANC 1B does have standing as a protestant. Anyone present on behalf of the group of 40 ?

MR. KENSEK: Ms. Fletcher, I'm sorry to interrupt. I'm also Commissioner 1B05, I'm just working with Larry. I thank you for everything, for sending me everything on Friday. My name is spelled A-L-A-N last name Kensek K-E-N-S-E-K and I'm representing $1 B$ as well with Larry. Thank you.

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you. K-E-N-S-EK.

MR. KENSEK: Yes, ma'am. A-L-A-N K-E-N-S-E-K and that's for everything you're doing.

MS. FLETCHER: Okay, thank you very
much, you're welcome. Anyone present on behalf of the group of 40?

MS. SCHECKMAN: Yes, Rachel Scheckman R-A-C-H-E-L S-C-H-E-C-K-M-A-N and we have several others here as well.

MS. FLETCHER: Okay, I will get their names in just a minute. I'm ready. If the others (Simultaneous speaking.) if you will state your name and spell it for the record, please.

MS. DAHL: Sure, Emily Dahl E-M-I-L-Y D-A-H-L.

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you. Anyone else?

MR. BURKARD: Daniel Burkard D-A-N-I-E-L last name $B-U-R-K-A-R-D$.

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you.
MS. SANTHOUSE: Kaylyn Santhouse K-A-Y-L-Y-N S-A-N-T-H-O-U-S-E.

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you.
MS. SANTHOUSE: Thank you. There goes my video.

MR. JEDZINAK: And this is Daniel Jedzinak D-A-N-I-E-L J-E-D-Z-I-N-A-K. Thank you.

MS. FLETCHER: Daniel, that was J-E-D?
MR. JEDZINAK: Yes, so $J$ as in Jason-E
as in Eric-D as in David-Z as in Zachary-I as in India-N as in Nancy-A as in apple-K as in kilo.

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you. Almost got it right. (Laughter.)

MR. JEDZINAK: I spell that a lot. Anybody else?

MS. LYNCH: My name is Arvia Lynch A-R-V as in victory-I-A, last name is Lynch L-Y-N-C-H.

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you, Ms. Lynch. Anyone else? Okay.

MS. SCHECKMAN: That might be it. I know someone else had logged in, but they had to go.

MS. FLETCHER: Okay, well you've got more than five and so the full group will be granted standing.

MS. SCHECKMAN: Thank you so much.
MS. FLETCHER: Including you, Ms. Scheckman, I count six people. Ms. Yohannes, do you have a different number?

MS. YOHANNES: No, ma'am, that's six.
MS. FLETCHER: Thank you. I count a total number of six individuals present, which means that the full group has standing as
protestants. We have two protestants in this matter, ANC 1B and the group of 40.

We need to set a date for a status hearing, protest hearing and a mediation. I'll give you the date for the status and protest hearing first. The status hearing is scheduled for February 15, 2023 at 10:30 a.m. The protest hearing is set for March 15 at 1:30 a.m.

MS. YOHANNES: PM.
MS. FLETCHER: What did I say? AM?
MR. KENSEK: Yes. (Laughter.)
MS. FLETCHER: I'm so used to saying a.m., yes, p.m. Thank you. We need to set a date for mediation. I'll give you the next available day. The next available day for mediation is Wednesday, January 11. That's a Board hearing day so $I$ don't know if anyone else present has any other hearings before the Board on that day.

MS. YOHANNES: I likely will so I would prefer not to have a Wednesday date.

MS. FLETCHER: How about Tuesday, January 17?

MR. HANDERHAN: Works for me.
MS. YOHANNES: That works for me as
well.
MS. SCHECKMAN: That works for me also.

MS. FLETCHER: What time? Any time between 10:00 and 1:30 is good.

MS. YOHANNES: And I'm sorry, Afshin, I just want to confer with my client, who's on the call.

MR. MOTTAGHI: Yeah, that works for me, Tuesday the 17 th .

MS. YOHANNES: Good.
MS. FLETCHER: So what time are we looking at? Any time between 10:00 and 1:30.

MS. SCHECKMAN: Rachel Scheckman. My schedule is open.

MR. HANDERHAN: Same here. I might as well -- I mean I would propose 10:00 unless people can't do that.

MR. KENSEK: Yeah, I want to second Larry on that, 10:00 a.m. would be great.

MS. FLETCHER: Okay.
MS. YOHANNES: I'm fine for 10:00 a.m.
MS. FLETCHER: What time?
MS. YOHANNES: I'm fine for 10:00 a.m.
MS. FLETCHER: So, that was Sidon

Yohannes speaking.
MS. YOHANNES: Yes.
MS. FLETCHER: I forgot to ask you all to let the court reporter know who was speaking, but that was Sidon Yohannes. Mr. Kensek, you said that you're available?

MR. KENSEK: Yes, ma'am (Simultaneous speaking.)

MS. FLETCHER: At 10:00?
MR. KENSEK: Both Larry and I, Larry spoke first said he was, Larry Handerhan, Commission of 1B01.

MS. FLETCHER: Yes.
MR. KENSEK: And then I seconded that I was also available at one o'clock as well, or 10:00, sorry.

MS. FLETCHER: Perfect, thank you.
MS. SCHECKMAN: And I, Rachel Scheckman, am also available.

MS. FLETCHER: Oh, Ms. Scheckman, hi. You're available at 10:00 as well, right? Okay, so now the court reporter has everybody's name. Thank you. So, mediation is set for Tuesday, January 17 at 10:00 a.m. I'll send you the Webex invitations and I'll see you then.

MS. YOHANNES: Great, thank you.
MS. FLETCHER: Any questions? You're welcome.

MR. KENSEK: Thank you, Your Honor. Appreciate you.

MS. FLETCHER: You're welcome.
MR. MOTTAGHI: Thank you.
MS. SCHECKMAN: Thank you for your time.

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you, Ms. Holtaze (Phonetic.). No, that's Ms. Scheckman. Thank you, Ms. Scheckman. The roll call hearing in this matter is concluded.
