3 MS. FLETCHER: The next case on the
4 calendar is Library Tavern. This is case number
5 22-PRO-00151. Library Tavern, LLC 5420 3rd
6 Street, NW, license number ABRA 105058. This a
7 Retailer Class CT license renewal. The protest
8 issues are adverse impact on peace, order and
9 quiet and residential parking.

10 My name is LaVerne Fletcher conducting
11 the Roll Call Hearing as the Board's agent. Is
12 anyone present on behalf of Library Tavern?

13 MR. BUTLER:& Yes, Jeremy Butler.

14 MS. FLETCHER:& Mr. Butler, will you
15 spell your name for the record, please?

16 MR. BUTLER:& Yes, it's Jeremy J-E-R-E-
17 M-Y Butler B-U-T-L-E-R.

18 MS. FLETCHER:& Thank you very much and
19 behalf of ANC 4D? Anyone present on behalf of
20 ANC 4D? ANC 4D is not present for the roll call
21 hearing this morning, therefore, the protest
22 filed by ANC 4D is dismissed.

23 Mr. Butler, ANC 4D is going to receive
24 a Board order dismissing the protest because
25 they're not present today. You'll receive a copy

1 of the Board order and if they seek reinstatement
2 of the protest, you will be informed and have an
3 opportunity to respond to their request for
4 reinstatement.

5 MR. BUTLER:& No problem. I've spoken
6 to the chairman of the ANC 4D, and I know both of
7 us, I think, may have a little confusion about
8 what it was because they, as part of the renewal
9 application, I also put in an application to
10 amend or cancel the settlement agreement.

11 They never had any intentions of
12 challenging the renewal, they just want a chance
13 to -- their purpose of their protest was to get a
14 protest in to be able to negotiate the settlement
15 agreement. The renewal itself --

16 MS. FLETCHER:& Well then, okay, thanks
17 for bringing that to my attention. I will look
18 into that. So, you believe they intended to file
19 only against the amendment for termination of the
20 settlement agreement?

21 MR. BUTLER:& Correct.

22 MS. FLETCHER:& Okay, well thank you
23 for that, Mr. Butler. Any other questions or any
24 other information you'd like to provide?

25 MR. BUTLER:& No, I don't have anything

1 else.

2 MS. FLETCHER:& Okay, well thank you
3 very much. The roll call hearing in this matter
4 is concluded. Thank you.
