MS. FLETCHER: The next case on the calendar is MK Lounge, case number 22-PRO-00121, Family LLC 1930 9th Street, NW. License number ABRA 088787. This is a Retailer Class CT license renewal. The protest issues are adverse impact on peace, order and quiet, real property values, residential parking and vehicular and pedestrian safety and noncompliance with the settlement agreement.

My name is LaVerne Fletcher conducting the Roll Call Hearing as the Board's agent.

MR. SCHLOM: Yes, good morning. Evan Schlom E-V-A-N last name is $S$ as in Sam-C as in Charlie-H-L-O-M as in Mary and I'm the abutting property owner protestant. Good morning.

MS. FLETCHER: Thank you, Mr. Schlom. Mr. Schlom does have standing as an abutting property owner. ANC 1B does have standing as a protestant. We need to first of all(Simultaneous speaking.) was somebody going to say something? Is anyone here from MK Lounge?

MR. BIANCO: Yes, Ms. Fletcher, Richard Bianco R-I-C-H-A-R-D B-I-A-N-C-O, counsel for MK Lounge.

MS. FLETCHER: We need to set a date for status hearing, protest hearing and a mediation. I'll give you the date for the status and protest hearing first. The status hearing is scheduled for March 1st, 2023 at 10:30. The
protest hearing is set for March 29 at 1:30. The next available day for mediation is Friday, January 20, any time between 10:00 and 1:30.

MR. BIANCO: This is Richard Bianco. I'd like to push it later on that date if possible.

MS. FLETCHER: Okay.
MR. BIANCO: I have proceedings in the morning, so 1:00 p.m. if that works for people? MS. FLETCHER: We can do 1:00 it works on this end.

MR. ORLASKEY: Like I said with the last one, it's kind of up to you guys.

MR. SCHLOM: This is Evan Schlom, 1:00 p.m. on Friday, January 20 is fine with me.

MS. FLETCHER: Okay. Ms. Harris and Mr. Orlaskey?

MR. ORLASKEY: Yeah, this is Dan Orlaskey. Again, it's up to you guys since I won't be around for that.

MS. FLETCHER: Okay, Ms. Harris, what about you?

MS. HARRIS: That works for me.
MS. FLETCHER: Okay, mediation is set for January 20 at 10:00 a.m.

MR. SCHLOM: Sorry, my understanding is mediation was set for Friday, the 20th at 1:00 p.m., not 10:00 a.m.

MS. FLETCHER: I need to put my glasses on. Thank you.

MR. SCHLOM: Sure. I just know Mr. Bianco said he wasn't available in the morning, so I want to make sure the time (Simultaneous speaking.)

MS. FLETCHER: Yes, thank you. Assuming I would have caught it later, but I'm not sure about that, so thanks for bringing that to my attention, Mr. Schlom. One o'clock p.m. on the 20th.
