### 1 P-R-O-C-E-E-D-I-N-G-S 2 10:27 a.m. 3 MS. FLETCHER: The next case on the 4 calendar is The Big Board. This is Case Number 5 22-PRO-00145, Drane Flannery Restaurant, LLC, 421 H Street, Northeast, License Number ABRA-087398. 6 7 This is a Retailer Class CT license renewal. 8 The protest issues are adverse impact 9 on real property values, peace, order, and quiet, 10 and residential and vehicular and pedestrian 11 safety. 12 My name is LaVerne Fletcher conducting 13 the roll call hearing as the Board's agent. 14 Is anyone present on behalf of The Big 15 Board? 16 MR. FLANNERY: Yes, Ms. Fletcher, this 17 is Eric Flannery, pardon me, there's a siren 18 going by the establishment right now. My name is 19 spelled E-R-I-C. My last name is spelled F-L-A-20 N-N like November, November, E-R-Y. 21 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you, Mr. 22 Flannery. And on behalf of ANC 6C? 23 24 MR. ECKENWILER: Good morning, Ms. 25 Fletcher, Mark Eckenwiler, Vice Chair for ANC 6C,

	that's C like Charlie, also Commissioner for
2	single-member District 6C04. My name is Mark, M-
3	A-R-K, last name Echo, Charlie, Kilo, Echo,
4	November, Whiskey, India, Lima, Echo, Romeo.
5	MS. FLETCHER: Did the court reporter
6	get that? I'll take it that you did.
7	COURT REPORTER: Yes, ma'am, I'm
8	looking at his name on Zoom.
9	MS. FLETCHER: Oh good, okay, perfect.
10	Thank you.
11	Mr. Eckenwiler, is anybody else
12	present from ANC from the ANC today?
13	MR. ECKENWILER: Not for this matter.
14	MS. FLETCHER: Okay, thank you.
15	The ANC 6C does have standing as a
16	protestant.
17	We'll set a date for a status hearing,
18	protest hearing, and mediation. I'll give you
19	the date for the status and protest hearing
20	first.
21	The status hearing is set for February
22	15, February 15, 2023.
23	MR. FLANNERY: Ms. Fletcher, could you
24	just repeat that's 1-5?
25	MS. FLETCHER: Yes, yes, 1-5, February

1	1-5, February 15 at 10:30 a.m.
2	The protest hearing is set for March
3	15, 2023 at 1:30.
4	We need to set a date for mediation.
5	There are two days left available in the month of
6	January, they're both on Wednesday, January 4 and
7	January 11 are available in January. Are either
8	one of those dates good?
9	MR. ECKENWILER: Mark Eckenwiler, Ms.
10	Fletcher, I would propose sometime January 11.
11	MS. FLETCHER: What about you, Mr.
12	Flannery? Are you available on January 11?
13	MR. FLANNERY: This is Mr. Flannery.
14	I don't know the answer to whether I'm available
15	because my lawyer is down in Antarctica right
16	now. I would prefer a later meeting date, but if
17	January 11 is the latest that we can have
18	MS. FLETCHER: No, we can
19	MR. FLANNERY: that is what I would
20	pick.
21	MS. FLETCHER: We can move to the
22	month of February. I'll give you the next
23	available date in February. The next available
24	date in February is Wednesday, February the 1st.
25	MR. FLANNERY: This is once again Eric

1	Flannery speaking. That's Wednesday, February
2	1st?
3	MS. FLETCHER: Yes, anytime between
4	10:00 and 1:30.
5	MR. FLANNERY: Once again, Eric
6	Flannery speaking. I would prefer later in the
7	afternoon as I tend to work late nights.
8	MS. FLETCHER: Okay, well, 1:30 is
9	available on Wednesday, February 1 if that's good
10	for Mr. Eckenwiler.
11	MR. ECKENWILER: Mark Eckenwiler, just
12	in the interest of moving this along, I'm pretty
13	much agreeable to anytime. I don't expect this
14	to take long.
15	I should note, though, that I'm
16	currently set to report to jury service on the
17	day before. Normally, that means one day in and
18	out. If I get picked for a trial, though, I
19	would not be available on February 1st.
20	But I'm happy to go ahead and pencil
21	that in right now and then I can let you know if
22	circumstances change.
23	MS. FLETCHER: Okay, let's see, would
24	well, I guess we may as well start there
25	because if you get a case, you don't know yes,

1	we can we'll just start with that and see what
2	happens.
3	MR. ECKENWILER: Let's put this way,
4	in a quarter century living in D.C., I have never
5	once been seated on a jury and I get called every
6	two years. So, I think the odds are pretty low.
7	MS. FLETCHER: Yes, well then,
8	mediation is set for February the 1st at 1:30
9	p.m.
10	MR. ECKENWILER: Thank you.
11	MS. FLETCHER: Okay, any questions at
12	all?
13	MR. FLANNERY: Ms. Fletcher, Flannery
14	speaking, and I don't have any questions. Thank
15	you very much for your time.
16	MS. FLETCHER: Well, thank you very
17	much. I will see you on Wednesday, February 1 at
18	1:30. Thank you for coming.
19	The roll call hearing in this matter
20	is concluded.
