3 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: So we are back  
4 on the record. Our -- the case that is on our --  
5 I am about to call is Case No. 18-CMP-00218, 12  
6 Twelve DC/Kyss Kyss, License No. 72734.

7 Will the parties, please, approach and  
8 identify themselves for the record, please?

9 MS. FLETCHER: Michele Fletcher, the  
10 owner.

11 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning,  
12 Ms. Fletcher.

13 MS. FLETCHER: Good morning.

14 MR. ADAMS: Good morning, Mr.  
15 Chairman. Walter Adams representing the District  
16 of Columbia.

17 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning,  
18 Mr. Adams. Mr. Adams, are there any preliminary  
19 matters in this case?

20 MR. ADAMS: There is, Mr. Chairman.  
21 The parties have discussed this matter prior to  
22 the hearing and are able to propose an Offer in

1       Compromise.

2                       There is a single charge for the  
3       establishment operating a sidewalk cafe without  
4       an endorsement.  And to resolve that, the parties  
5       are proposing a fine in the amount of \$1,500 to  
6       be paid in a period of 60 days.  If the  
7       establishment does not pay such fine within the  
8       60 day period, the license shall be suspended  
9       indefinitely until the fine is paid.

10                      CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON:  All right.  Ms.  
11       Fletcher, it's my understanding that there is an  
12       Offer in Compromise and the Offer in Compromise  
13       is that there is a fine of \$1,500 payable within  
14       60 days.  If the fine is not payable in 60 days,  
15       the license will be suspended until the fine has  
16       been paid.

17                      Is this your understanding of the  
18       Offer in Compromise?

19                      MS. FLETCHER:  Yes, it is.

20                      CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON:  All right.

21                      MS. FLETCHER:  And I also have my  
22       paperwork for the sidewalk cafe in.

1                   CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. Are  
2 you aware that by accepting an Offer in  
3 Compromise, that you are giving up your right to  
4 a hearing?

5                   MS. FLETCHER: Yes, yes.

6                   CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And that you  
7 are giving up your right to appeal this matter?

8                   MS. FLETCHER: Yes.

9                   CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right.  
10 Thank you. With that said, I make a motion that  
11 the Offer in Compromise of a fine of \$1,500 be  
12 payable in 60 days. If the fine is not payable  
13 in 60 days, the license will be suspended until  
14 the fine has been paid. Is there a second?

15                   MEMBER SHORT: Second.

16                   CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Short has  
17 seconded the motion.

18                   All those in favor say aye.

19                   ALL: Aye.

20                   CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Those opposed?  
21 The matter passes 5-0-0.

22                   I want to thank the parties for

1 agreeing to this matter and you need to sign-off  
2 on the paperwork and thank you for being here  
3 today. And thank you for --

4 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you.

5 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: -- following  
6 through to make sure that you are legal as far as  
7 the Agency is concerned. All right. Have a  
8 great day.
