ORDER APPROVING MOTION TO WITHDRAW APPLICATION

The above-mentioned parties appeared before the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) on May 22, 2024 for a Protest Status Hearing. At the hearing, the Applicant moved to withdraw its application and informed the Board that they had placed the license in safekeeping.

ORDER

Therefore, on this 22nd day of May 2024, the Board **GRANTS** the motion to withdraw the application. The license shall be deemed **INACTIVE** and no alcohol sales shall be permitted at the establishment until the license is removed from safekeeping. The current and all future hearings related to this matter have been cancelled. The Board advises the parties that the license will be subject to protest on its renewal upon the removal of the license from safekeeping. A copy of this Order shall be provided to the parties.

Pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-433(d)(1), any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration, Reeves Center, 2000 14th Street, NW, 400S, Washington, D.C. 20009.

Also, pursuant to section 11 of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code § 2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202-879-1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR § 1719.1 stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. *See* D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).
