1 P-R-O-C-E-E-D-I-N-G-S 2 10:20 a.m. Would the parties in 3 AGENT FLETCHER: 4 the matter of 4 Seasons Convenience Store, 5 please, come forward? 4 Seasons Convenience 6 This is Case No. 18-PRO-00038, Badsri Store. 7 Incorporated, 4975 South Dakota Avenue, N.E., 8 License No. ABRA-109434. This is a Retailer 9 Class B new application. 10 The protest issues are adverse impact 11 on peace, order and quiet. 12 My name is LaVerne Fletcher. I'm 13 conducting the Roll Call Hearing as the Board's 14 Agent. 15 Introductions beginning with the 16 applicant, please. 17 MR. DIETZ: My name is Bernard C. 18 I'm representing the applicant, Badsri, 19 I have with me Ms. Saba Bocure, who is the Inc. 20 president of Badsri, Inc., and Mr. Petros Kiflu,

who is the principal of Badsri, Inc.

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1	Dietz, would you spell your last name for the
2	record, please?
3	MR. DIETZ: D-I-E-T-Z.
4	AGENT FLETCHER: Thank you. And could
5	you state your name, please, and spell it?
6	MR. KIFLU: Kiflu, K-I-F, like Frank,
7	L-U.
8	AGENT FLETCHER: Is that the last name
9	or first name?
10	MR. KIFLU: Last name.
11	AGENT FLETCHER: And what's the first
12	name?
13	MR. KIFLU: P-E-T-R-O-S.
14	AGENT FLETCHER: P-E-T-R?
15	MR. KIFLU: O-S.
16	AGENT FLETCHER: O-L.
17	MS. BOCURE: Saba, the first name is
18	S-A-B-A. My last name is Bocure, B-O-C-U-R-E.
19	AGENT FLETCHER: B-O-C-U?
20	MS. BOCURE: R-E.
21	AGENT FLETCHER: And the first name is
22	S-A?

1	MS. BOCURE: B-A.
2	AGENT FLETCHER: B like boy?
3	MS. BOCURE: Yeah.
4	AGENT FLETCHER: Okay. Thank you very
5	much.
6	Is anyone present on behalf of ANC-5A?
7	Is anyone present on behalf of ANC-5A?
8	MR. LEWIS: I was trying to reach the
9	chair. I don't think he is here at the moment,
10	but I'm an ANC-5A02.
11	AGENT FLETCHER: Is anyone present on
12	behalf of the North Michigan Park Civic
13	Association?
14	MR. LEWIS: I'm Grace Lewis.
15	AGENT FLETCHER: You are present on
16	behalf of the North Michigan Park Civic
17	Association?
18	MR. LEWIS: Yes, I am.
19	AGENT FLETCHER: And your name,
20	please?
21	MR. LEWIS: Grace J. Lewis.
22	AGENT FLETCHER: Thank you, Ms. Lewis.

1	Would you spell your name for the record?
2	MR. LEWIS: G-R-A-C-E.
3	AGENT FLETCHER: Uh-huh.
4	MR. LEWIS: Initial J, L-E-W-I-S.
5	AGENT FLETCHER: Thank you very much.
6	Is anyone present on behalf of ANC-5A?
7	Ms. Lewis, I have a couple of
8	questions for you. In order to determine whether
9	or not your association has standing as a
10	protestant, I have a couple of questions for you.
11	MR. LEWIS: Okay.
12	AGENT FLETCHER: Are you incorporated
13	in D.C.?
14	MR. LEWIS: No, we are not.
15	AGENT FLETCHER: I just have a couple
16	more questions. Did your association hold a
17	meeting concerning this application where you
18	voted?
19	MR. LEWIS: Yes.
20	AGENT FLETCHER: Was it a duly called
21	meeting?

AGENT FLETCHER: Was the applicant given at least a 7-day notice to attend the meeting?

MR. LEWIS: No.

AGENT FLETCHER: Okay. Thank you. What that means, Ms. Lewis, is that your association cannot be granted standing as a protestant.

In order to be granted standing as a protestant, as a community association, you have to be incorporated in D.C. And this is for future reference you can --

MR. LEWIS: Okay.

AGENT FLETCHER: -- get these things done. You have to be incorporated in D.C. If you are going to hold a meeting concerning this application, you have to give the applicant at least a 7-day notice of the meeting that you are going to hold and invite them to the meeting to give them an opportunity to attend the meeting.

If they don't attend the meeting, that's not a requirement, but it is a requirement

1	that you let them know when the meeting is that
2	you are going to hold concerning the application.
3	The North Michigan Park Civic
4	Association is dismissed as a protestant.
5	ANC-5A is dismissed, because they
6	failed to appear today.
7	So as of today, there are no
8	protestants in this matter.
9	Ms. Lewis, your association has the
10	right to petition the ABC Board to be granted
11	standing as a protestant, but based
12	MR. LEWIS: May I ask you a question?
13	AGENT FLETCHER: Yes.
14	MR. LEWIS: Since I'm a member of ANC-
15	5A and Commissioner of ANC-5A02, can I represent
16	5A?
17	AGENT FLETCHER: Well, they didn't
18	designate you as a representative. They
19	designated, I believe, the chair. Yes, they have
20	to be present. Give me one second.
21	I'm going to dismiss 5A. 5A and also
22	your association will receive an order from the

ABC Board dismissing your protest, but you will 1 2 have 10 days to seek reinstatement if for some reason you would like the Board to reconsider --3 4 MR. LEWIS: Okay. AGENT FLETCHER: -- the decision today 5 ANC-5A is dismissed, to dismiss the protest. 6 7 because they are not here and they didn't 8 designate you as a representative. 9 So we have 10 days to --MR. LEWIS: 10 AGENT FLETCHER: Once you receive the 11 Board Order dismissing the protest, the Board 12 Order will tell you that you have 10 days to ask 13 the Board to grant you standing as a protestant. 14 MR. LEWIS: Okay. And if you decide to 15 AGENT FLETCHER: 16 do that, then you have got to inform, Mr. Dietz, 17 so that he will have an opportunity to respond to 18 your request to be reinstated as a protestant or 19 to be granted standing as a protestant. 20 MR. LEWIS: Okay. 21 AGENT FLETCHER: Any questions at all? 22 MR. LEWIS: Okay. But as far as the

association, we have to be incorporated in D.C.? 1 2 AGENT FLETCHER: In order to file a protest in the future, if say you want to file a 3 4 protest beyond today --5 MR. LEWIS: Um-hum. -- the requirements 6 AGENT FLETCHER: 7 are that you are incorporated in D.C., that's 8 first. The second thing is that you have to give 9 the applicant at least a 7-day notice of the meeting that you have regarding the application 10 11 that they are filing, so that they have an 12 opportunity to attend the meeting. 13 MR. LEWIS: Okay. So is it too late 14 to do that now? AGENT FLETCHER: It's too late. 15 16 would need to have been done before the petition 17 deadline. The petition deadline in this case was 18 March -- May, May 21st. 19 MR. LEWIS: Okay. 20 AGENT FLETCHER: So it's too late. 21 MR. LEWIS: Okay. 22 AGENT FLETCHER: Okay. Anything else?

1	MR. LEWIS: No, that's it.
2	MR. DIETZ: Um
3	AGENT FLETCHER: Mr. Dietz?
4	MR. DIETZ: Just for the record, I did
5	not receive notice of this protest. Okay. The
6	application filed has my Notice of Appearance and
7	today I filed a separate Notice of Appearance for
8	the protest, so to make sure that I get copies of
9	whatever notices you are sending.
10	AGENT FLETCHER: Okay. Thank you, Mr.
11	Dietz. Did you put your contact information on
12	that sheet also today?
13	MR. DIETZ: Yes, I did.
14	AGENT FLETCHER: Okay.
15	MR. DIETZ: And I just gave the
16	gave her a copy of that also.
17	AGENT FLETCHER: Okay. Will do.
18	MR. DIETZ: Okay?
19	AGENT FLETCHER: Yes.
20	MR. DIETZ: Just so I know what is
21	going on.
22	AGENT FLETCHER: Absolutely.

Thank you very much. 1 MR. DIETZ: 2 AGENT FLETCHER: Okay. Thank you. The Roll Call Hearing is concluded. Thank you. 3 4 (Whereupon, the hearing briefly went 5 off the record.) Can we reopen the record for a moment 6 in the matter of 4 Seasons Convenience Store? 7 8 I just want to clarify for the record 9 that the North Michigan Park Civic Association was dismissed, but in their Protest Letter, they 10 11 indicated that there were a group of residents 12 that signed a petition and the association 13 attached a copy of a petition to its Protest 14 Letter. I'm checking now to see if there are 15 16 any individuals here connected to the North 17 Michigan Park Civic Association. 18 individuals? 19 Thank you. And just for the record, I will note that if either one of those 20 21 individuals had appeared today, they would not have been recognized as protestants, because they 22

did not claim to be protestants and did not state a claim under the Appropriateness Standard. So the fact that they are not here today is fine, because they are not recognized as protestants. We can close the record now. Thank you. (Whereupon, the Roll Call Hearing was concluded at 10:31 a.m.)
