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**ORDER ON DISMISSAL OF PROTESTS**

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The Application filed by Badsri Incorporated, t/a 4 Seasons Convenience Store, for a new Retailer's Class B License, having been protested, came before the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) for a Roll Call Hearing on June 4, 2018, in accordance with D.C. Official Code § 25-601 (2001).

On June 4, 2018, the Board dismissed the Protests of ANC 5A and North Michigan Park Civic Association (NMPCA).

ANC 5A was dismissed because failed to appear at the Roll Call Hearing.

NMPCA was dismissed because 1) it is not a “citizens association incorporated under the laws of the District of Columbia located within the affected area” in accordance with D.C. Official Code § 25-601(3); and 2) it did not give the Applicant at least seven (7) days advanced notice of the NMPCA meeting, pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-601(3)(B).

ANC 5A and NMPCA may file a Request for Reinstatement with the Board within ten (10) days from the date of this Order.

### **ORDER**

The Board does hereby, this 6th day of June, 2018, **DISMISS** the Protests of ANC 5A and NMPCA. Copies of this Order shall be sent to the Applicant, ANC 5A, and NMPCA.







Pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-433(d)(1), any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration, 2000 14<sup>th</sup> Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, DC 20009.

Also, pursuant to section 11 of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code §2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202/879-1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).
