
ORDER RESCINDING APPROVAL OF SUMMER GARDEN ENDORSEMENT

600 T, LLC t/a 600 T (Applicant), filed an Application for a Substantial Change to its Retailer's Class CT License (Application) at 600 T Street, NW. Specifically, the nature of the substantial change sought by the Applicant was for a Summer Garden endorsement with twenty-eight (28) seats.

The Application was placarded on July 10, 2020, and no protests were filed. On October 24, 2020, the Board approved the application conditioned upon the filing of a Certificate of Occupancy for the summer garden space. To date, notwithstanding numerous requests from ABCA's Licensing Division, the Applicant has not completed the licensing process in order to have the endorsement issued.

Therefore, on this 4th day of October 2023, pursuant to 23 DCMR 500.2, the Board **RESCINDS** approval of 600 T's Summer Garden endorsement and dismisses the Substantial Change Application. A copy of this Order shall be sent to the Applicant.

Official Code §2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thi1ty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202/879-1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).
