5 Street Market, License No. 88611.

7 identify themselves for the record, please? All

5 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And you are the
6 interpreter. Okay. Fine. Thank you, sir. And
7 please, sign-in. Go ahead, ma'am.

8 MS. CHOE: Good morning. My name is
9 Eun Sun Choe. I coming from L Street Market.

10 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: You are the
11 owner, ma'am?

12 MS. CHOE: Yes.

13 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Okay. Ms.
14 Schmidt?

15 MS. SCHMIDT: Amy Schmidt, Assistant
16 Attorney General, on behalf of the District of
17 Columbia.

18 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning
19 again.

20 Are there any preliminary matters in
21 this case?

22 MS. SCHMIDT: No. No, there are not.

1 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. Is
2 the Government ready to move forward with our
3 hearing?

4 MS. SCHMIDT: This is hearing --

5 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Oh, I'm sorry.
6 I apologize.

7 MS. SCHMIDT: Please, not yet.

8 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: I apologize,

22 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: My apologies.

1 The matter is scheduled for February 13th at
2 11:00 a.m. Thank you for pointing that out, Ms.
3 Schmidt, to me. I have my notes here and I
4 should have corrected it this morning when I was
5 told of the date. So February 13th at 11:00
6 a.m., ma'am.

7 MS. SCHMIDT: Fine.

8 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And what that
9 means is that at that hearing, if you have
10 documents or witnesses, you bring them there.
11 One of the things that I have also asked both
12 parties to do is that seven days before the
13 hearing, you should exchange documents and
14 witnesses with the other side and also provide us
15 with a copy of the -- of your documents and
