3 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. The  
4 next case on our calendar is Case No. 18-CMP-  
5 00145, 801 Restaurant & Bar, License No. 103120.

6 Would the parties, please, approach  
7 and identify themselves for the record, please?

8 MS. PHILLIPS: Louise Phillips,  
9 Assistant Attorney General, for the District of  
10 Columbia.

11 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Phillips.

12 MS. YOHANNES: Sidon Yohannes on  
13 behalf of the licensee.

14 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Yohannes.

15 Ms. Phillips, is there -- are there  
16 any preliminary matters in this case?

17 MS. PHILLIPS: Yes, Mr. Chair, there  
18 are. This is a one charge case. The Offer in  
19 Compromise is a fine of \$1,250 to be paid within  
20 30 days or the license will be suspended until  
21 paid.

22 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Yohannes,

1 it's my understanding that there is an Offer in  
2 Compromise and the Offer in Compromise is that  
3 there is a fine of \$1,250 payable within 30 days.  
4 If the fine is not payable in 30 days, the  
5 license will be suspended.

6 Is this your understanding of the  
7 Offer in Compromise?

8 MS. YOHANNES: Yes.

9 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Is your client  
10 aware that by accepting an Offer in Compromise,  
11 that they are giving up their right to a hearing?

12 MS. YOHANNES: Yes.

13 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And is your  
14 client also aware that by accepting an Offer in  
15 Compromise, that they are giving up their right  
16 to appeal this matter?

17 MS. YOHANNES: Yes.

18 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: With this said,  
19 I then make a motion that the Offer in Compromise  
20 of a fine of \$1,250 payable in 30 days be  
21 accepted. If it is not payable in 30 days, the  
22 license will be suspended until the fine has been

1 paid.

2 Is there a second?

3 MEMBER SHORT: Second.

4 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Short has  
5 seconded the motion.

6 All those in favor say aye.

7 ALL: Aye.

8 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Those opposed?

9 The matter passes 4-0-0.

10 MS. YOHANNES: Thank you.

11 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Thank you.
