ORDER ON DISMISSAL OF JULIA AND GERARD ITTIG'S PROTEST

The Application filed by Venus 2, Inc., t/a 9 & P St. Liquor (Applicant), for renewal of its Retailer's Class A License, having been protested, came before the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) for a Roll Call Hearing on July 12, 2021.

On July 12, 2021, the Board's Agent dismissed the Protest of Julia B. Ittig and Gerard W. Ittig because they did not claim to be abutting property owners or to be part of a Group of Five or More Individuals.

Moreover, Julia and Gerald Ittig failed to appear at the Roll Call Hearing and are dismissed for that reason as well. Julia and Gerald Ittig may seek reinstatement of their protest with the Board by demonstrating good cause for their failure to attend the hearing within ten (10) days from the date of this Order.

Pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-433(d)(1), any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration, 2000 14th Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, DC 20009.

Also, pursuant to section II of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code §2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202/879- 1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).
