And basically what this says is 17 that the 60 days will start once the Board Order 18 is issued. However, even if the Board Order is 19 not issued by May 26th, you are agreeing today 20 that you cannot sell or serve alcohol on May 21 26th. Is that correct? Is that -- you 22 understand that?
