ORDER TERMINATING PETITIONER'S SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

The official records of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) reflect that Fana, Inc., t/a Mudrick's Supermarket (Petitioner), entered into a Settlement Agreement with Advisory Neighborhood Commission (ANC) 5B, on March 10, 2009, and it was approved by the Board on July 1, 2009. The Petitioner now seeks to terminate its Settlement Agreement under D.C. Official Code § 25-446(d).

Notice of Petition was placarded on the Petitioner's premises and published in the D.C. Register. At the end of the protest period, the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board did not receive any objections to the filing. Therefore, the Petition is uncontested.

The Board is only required to produce findings of fact and conclusions of law on contested issues of fact. <u>See Craig v. District of Columbia Alcoholic Beverage Control</u> <u>Bd.</u>, 721 A.2d 584, 590 (D.C. 1998) ("The Board's regulations require findings only on contested issues of fact."); 23 DCMR § 1718.2. Accordingly, based on the Board's review of the Petition, Petitioner has satisfied all remaining requirements imposed by Title 25 and Title 23 to merit the termination of its Settlement Agreement by the Board.

ORDER

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Therefore, it is hereby **ORDERED** on this 14th day of January, 2021, that the Petition to Terminate its Settlement Agreement with ANC 5B dated March 10, 2009, filed by Fana, Inc., t/a Mudrick's Supermarket, at premises 1064 Bladensburg Road, NE, Washington, D.C. is hereby **GRANTED**. A copy of this Order shall be delivered to the Petitioner.

Official Code §2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thi1ty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Coult of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202/879- 1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).
