The Alcoholic Beverage Control Board met in Alcoholic Beverage Control Hearing Room, Reeves Building, 2000 14th Street N.W., Washington, D.C., Ms. LaVerne Fletcher, Agent, presiding.

AGENT FLETCHER: Okay. Would the parties in the matter of Addis Ethiopian Restaurant, please, come forward? The parties in the matter of Addis Ethiopian Restaurant.

This is Case No. 18-PRO-00065, 707 H Street, N.E., License No. ABRA-097534. This is a Retailer Class CR substantial change, expansion to the second and third floor; increase seating from 50 to 122; total occupancy load will increase from 65 to 269 for all three floors.

Is anyone present on behalf of Addis Ethiopian Restaurant?

I'll close the record on this one and recall it in about five minutes.

MR. ECKENWILER: ANC-6C is present.
AGENT FLETCHER: Is the -- oh, okay. Hi, I'll reopen the case then. Thank you.

Present on behalf of ANC?
MR. ECKENWILER: ANC-6C.
AGENT FLETCHER: Um-hum. Okay. If
you would state your name and spell it for the record, please?
