ORDER ON PRAECIPE OF DISMISSAL

On December 13, 2018, the District of Columbia (Government) filed a Praeceptum of Dismissal seeking dismissal of the charges listed in the Notices to Show Cause Hearing filed against Addis Ethiopian Restaurant, LLC, t/a Addis Ethiopian Restaurant (Respondent), in Case Nos. 18-AUD-00034, 18-CMP-00076 and 18-CMP-00077. *See* ABRA Show Cause File Nos. 18-AUD-00034, 18-CMP-00076 and 18-CMP-00077.

The Government seeks to dismiss the charge because on December 12, 2018, the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board cancelled the Respondent's License No. ABRA-097534. *See* Board Order No. 2018-740.

For these reasons, on this 13th day of December, 2018, the Board hereby **ACKNOWLEDGES** receipt of the Government's Praeceptum of Dismissal and **DISMISSES** Case Nos. 18-AUD-00034, 18-CMP-00076 and 18-CMP-00077 against the Respondent. 

Pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-433(d)(1), any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration, 2000 14th Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, DC 20009.

Also, pursuant to section 11 of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code §2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202/879-1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).
