The Alcoholic Beverage Control Board met via Videoconference, Chairperson Donovan W. Anderson presiding.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: I'm going to go a little bit out of order and read -- let me -that -- we had a protest hearing scheduled for 1:30 this afternoon on Entice Lounge, and before I state what this case is about, let me say this, before $I$ state what the position is.

All right. There have been a significant amount of filings by the parties in this case, and that's reflected in our licensing -- I'm sorry -- our legal agenda to -for today.

So before issuing a decision -- before announcing to the public what's going to happen with that -- our 1:30 case, I'm going to go to our Legal Agenda II, okay? Legal Agenda II, so I want the record to reflect this.

Now, I am not going to read the Board decisions for the second legal agenda. Legal Agenda II has 10 items on it, and all of them deal with the Eighteenth Street Lounge protest.

Before I read the specific decisions, I want the parties to understand the positions taken by the Board today. Various motions to continue the hearing were filed by the
protestants to allow for additional time to negotiate a settlement agreement. The Board is denying those motions.

Number one, the Applicant does not contest to the long continuance proposed by the protestants; two, the Applicant is entitled to an expedited hearing, pursuant to D.C. Official Code Section 25-432(b)(1), and three, no good cause exists.

The Board is persuaded that a lengthy continuance will produce a settlement agreement. However, given the number of motions filed by the parties so close to today's protest hearing, the Board and the parties will need additional time to prepare for the hearing.

Therefore, the Board is rescheduling the protest hearing to January 19, 2022 at 10:00 a.m.

Secondly, because the Board has rescheduled the hearing for one week, the protestants' additional request to continue the protest hearing due to a conflict with a guardianship hearing pending in another forum is now moot.

Thirdly, the Board further received a
motion from the Applicant to strike the Blagden Alley Naylor Court Association's supplement to motion for continuance of protest hearing. The Board is granting this motion because it contains information related to settlement negotiations which should remain confidential.

Additionally, the motion was not filed in accordance with the pleading schedule outlined in 23 DCMR Section 117 -- Section 1716. Lastly, the Board is aware that the parties have included allegations of witness tampering by the Applicant or another on the Applicant's behalf, pursuant to D.C. Official Code Section 25-434.

The Board takes these allegations seriously and thus will be referring this specific matter to ABRA's Enforcement Division for investigation.

This investigation will proceed on a separate track because the statute makes it a criminal matter, pursuant to D.C. Code Section 25-434(b). The investigation, however, does not require the Board to continue the protest hearing until it has been completed. Thank you.

So therefore I'm going to -- I am going to go through our Legal Agenda II. So our

Legal Agenda II is -- the first matter on our legal agenda is the review of ANC $2 F^{\prime}$ s motion for continuance of protest hearing dated January 5, 2022.

manner as practical. We are now adjourned for the day.
