CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: We will now do our Legal Agenda. There are two items on our Legal Agenda.

The first matter on our Legal Agenda is the review of an Offer in Compromise in lieu of a hearing, dated June 5, 2020, for Case Number 19-CC-00135, Politics and Prose, License Number 089388.

I am going to read the Offer in Compromise. And once I review the Offer in Compromise, I will ask that a board member second the approval of the Offer in Compromise, and then we'll vote on it.

So, this is the Offer in Compromise for Politics and Prose, License Number 19-CC00135. The District of Columbia, jointly with the Licensee Respondent, submits this Offer in Compromise, OIC, to the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board as authorized by 23 DCMR, Section 1604.5 for approval by the board.

The parties understand that if the board accepts the OIC, this case will be concluded, and the scheduled show cause hearing
will be vacated. Respondent will be obligated to abide by the terms of the OIC, and fines of suspension, close, or other terms shown below. If the board does not approve the OIC, the matter will be continued to the scheduled show cause hearing. The schedule is currently set for June 3, 2020.

The Respondent has been advised that there is no obligation for accepting OIC. Respondent has been advised through a service of the notice of status hearing and show cause hearing that at a show cause hearing, Respondent maybe represented by legal counsel, have subpoenas issued to remove the production of witnesses and evidence, produce witnesses and evidence, cross examine witnesses, and apply to the board for a qualified interpreter.

These are the OIC terms. Charge One, sale to minor. Pursuant to D.C. Official Code Section 25781, the Respondent will receive a warning.

Charge Two, fail to take reasonable steps necessary to ascertain legal drinking age, statutory authority, D.C. Code Section 25783. The charge, the board will issue a warning for
this matter.
On Charge Three, no ABC manager. That's statutory authority in D.C. Code Section 25701. The fine will be a 250 dollar fine to be paid within 90 days, or the license will be -the licensee -- the license will be suspended until the fine has been paid.

I then make a motion that the Offer in Compromise be accepted. Is there a second? MEMBER SHORT: Second.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. James Short has seconded the motion. I will now take a roll call vote on the motion before us to accept the Offer in Compromise for a written warning for Charge One, a written warning for Charge Two, and a 250 dollar fine to be payable within 90 days for Charge Three.

Mr. Short?
MEMBER SHORT: Mr. Short, I agree.
CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Bobby Cato?
MEMBER CATO: Bobby Cato, I agree.
CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Rema
Wahabzadah?
MEMBER WAHABZADAH: Rema Wahabzadah, I agree.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Rafi Crockett?

MEMBER CROCKETT: Rafi Crockett, I agree.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Jeni
Hansen?
MEMBER HANSEN: Jeni Hansen, I agree.
CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Ed Grandis?
MEMBER GRANDIS: Ed Grandis, I agree.
CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And Mr.
Anderson, $I$ agree. Therefore, the matter passes seven, zero, zero to accept the OIC.

All right. The next case on our calendar is also an Offer in Compromise dated June 9, 2020 for Case Number 19-CC-00097, Kogod Liquors, License Number 024868.

The Offer in Compromise states the following: the District of Columbia, jointly with the Licensee Respondent submits this Offer in Compromise, OIC to the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board as authorized by 23 DCMR Section 1604.5 for approval by the board.

The parties understand that if the board approves the OIC, this case will be concluded and the scheduled show cause hearing
will be vacated.
Respondent will be obligated to abide by the terms of the OIC, a fine substantial, suspension, close, or other terms drawn up below. If the board does not approve the OIC, this matter will be continued through the scheduled show cause hearing currently set for July 15, 2020.

The Respondent has been advised that there is no obligation to accept the OIC. Respondent has been advised through service of the notice of show cause hearing, and show -notice of hearing and show cause hearing, that at a show cause hearing Respondent may be represented by legal counsel, have subpoenas issued to require the production of witnesses and evidence produced that is in evidence, cross examine witnesses, and apply to the board for a qualified interpreter.

The terms of the OIC are, Charge One, sale to minor, statutory authority, D.C. Official Code Section 25781. There is a fine of 3,000 dollars to be paid within 90 days or the license will be suspended until the fine has been paid.

Charge Two, there has been a
suspension. The license shall be suspended for ten days with four days to be -- with four days to be served, and six days to be stayed for one year.

Additionally, the Respondent shall serve a five day suspension, which was activated with Case Number 19-CC-00011. The establishment shall therefore serve the suspension starting on June 11, 2020 and ending on June 19, 2020.

Charge -- the other term of Charge One is that all employees who serve alcoholic beverages in the licensed establishment, shall complete an alcoholic -- alcohol training programs within three months from the OIC date.

I then make a motion that the Offer in Compromise be accepted. Is there a second? MEMBER CROCKETT: Ms. Crockett seconds.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Crockett has seconded the motion. I will now take a roll call vote on the motion before us.

MEMBER GRANDIS: Mr. Chairman?
CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Yes, Mr.
Grandis?
MEMBER GRANDIS: If I understood, the
first Offer in Compromise we dealt with, one of them was a sale to minor that --

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Yes.
MEMBER GRANDIS: And then this one there's a sale to minor.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Yes, Mr.
Grandis.
MEMBER GRANDIS: Maybe, you know, I'm -- I may not have participated in something, because I'm new to the board. It's just, I'm just sort of puzzled on why one in the Offer in Compromise have the same as this one?

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Because they're two different charges. The first case the board is authorized to give a warning for a first time violation.

The second case, it was not a first time violation.

MEMBER GRANDIS: Ah.
CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: As you see, as a part of the suspension, the licensee is being suspended because in Case Number 19-CC-00011, a six day suspension was stayed, provided that they did not participate, they did not commit another violation within a year.

And in this particular case, unfortunately, the licensee committed another violation. And so therefore, that is why they have to serve an additional six day suspension.

So, it's two different cases.
MEMBER GRANDIS: Yeah. Yeah.
CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And they're different. Yes.

MEMBER GRANDIS: And I think you helped me understand, there's significant difference between the two. Thank you. CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. Fine. So, therefore --

MEMBER SHORT: Mr. Chairman?
CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Yes, Mr. Short?
MEMBER SHORT: What is the total
number of days that will be served?
CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: It's a ten day suspension.

MEMBER SHORT: Okay.
CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Six days -- I'm sorry, five days, nine days, I apologize.

MEMBER CROCKETT: Nine.
CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Nine, nine -they will actually serve nine days. Four days
from this case and five days from Case Number 19-CC-00011.

MEMBER SHORT: Thank you.
CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: So, a total of nine days starting June 11 and ending on June 19. Any other questions?

MEMBER SHORT: I do thank you.
CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Any other questions by any of the members before we vote?
(No response)
CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: So, with that, I know the -- I'm sorry, who had seconded the motion that $I$ made?

MEMBER SHORT: Rafi.
CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ah, Mr. Cato had seconded the motion.

MEMBER CROCKETT: No, Rafi had seconded the motion.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: I'm sorry. Ms. Crockett had seconded the motion for us to accept the OIC. And the OIC terms in the Kogod Liquor for Charge One, sale to minor it says $\mathbf{3 , 0 0 0}$ dollar fine to be paid within 90 days, or the ABC license will be suspended until the fine is paid.

Number two, the licensee shall be
suspended for ten days, with four days to be served, and six days stayed for one year. Additionally, the Respondent shall serve five day suspension which was activated from Case Number 19-CC-00011.

The establishment will therefore serve the suspension starting on June 11, 2020 and ending on June 19, 2020.

Charge -- I'm sorry, provision three of Charge -- of the charge is that all employees who serve alcoholic beverages in the licensed establishment must complete an alcoholic training program within three months from the OIC's date.

So the roll call vote now, 1 will call the members to vote on the approval of the Offer in Compromise. So, Mr. James Short?

MEMBER SHORT: Mr. James Short, I approve.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Bobby Cato?
MEMBER CATO: Bobby Cato, I agree.
