The matter is Hampton Inn and Suites, Washington, D.C. Navy Yard, License No. 099532. The offer in compromise is the following: The District of Columbia, jointly with the licensee respondent, submits this offer in compromise, OIC, to the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board as authorized by 23 DCMR Section 16-04.5 for approval by the Board.

The parties understand that if the Board approves the OIC, this case will be concluded and the scheduled Show Cause hearing will be vacated. Respondent will be obligated to abide by the terms of the OIC, a fine, suspension, both or other terms shown below. If the Board does not approve the OIC, the matter

shall be continued to the scheduled Show Cause hearing currently scheduled for May 20, 2020. The Respondent has been advised that there is no obligation to accept an OIC.

Respondent has been advised through notice of the notice of status hearing and Show Cause hearing, that at the Show Cause hearing, Respondent may be represented by legal counsel, have subpoenas issued to require the production of witnesses and evidence, produce witnesses and evidence, cross-examine witnesses and apply to the Board for a qualified interpreter.

The OIC terms are as follows: On charge 1, failure to meet the food service requirement of \$2,000.00 per occupant or 45 percent of the gross annual receipt. The statutory authority is DC Code Section 25-113, Section (e)(5)(B)(I), and Section 25-113, Section (e)(5)(B)(ii). The fine for this is \$1,000.00 to be paid within 90 days or the ABC Board will suspend until the fine has been paid. Is there a second?

OIC is as follows: The District of Columbia, jointly with the licensee respondent, submits this offer in compromise, OIC, to the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board and authorized under 23 DCMR Section 1604.5 for approval by the Board.

The parties understand that if the Board approves this OIC, this case will be concluded and the scheduled Show Cause hearing would be vacated. Respondent will be obligated to abide by the terms of the OIC, a fine, suspension, both, or other terms shown below. If the Board does not approve the OIC, the matter will be continued to the scheduled Show Cause hearing currently not yet set. The Respondent has been advised that there is no obligation to accept an OIC.

Respondent has been advised through service of the notice of status hearing and Show Cause hearing that at Show Cause hearing Respondent may be represented by legal counsel, have subpoenas issued to require the production of witnesses and evidence, produce witnesses and evidence, cross-examine witnesses and apply to the Board for a qualified interpreter. The terms of the OIC are as follows:

on duty. The statutory authority is DC Code Section 25-701. The fine will be \$1,000.00 within 90 days, or the ABC Board will suspend until this fine has been paid. The second charge is Charge 2, license not conspicuously posted and settlement agreement not accessible. The statutory authority is DC Code Section 25-711(a). The Board will be issuing a warning for this matter.

For Charge 3, change of trade name without Board approval, the statutory authority 23 DCMR Section 600.1, a warning will be issued. Charge 4, sale of single container of beer, the statutory authority is DC Code Section 25-341, a warning will be issued. Charge No. 4, change of ownership without Board approval, the statutory authority DC Code Section 25-405. It is a \$1,000.00 fine paid within 90 days or the ABC license will be suspended until the fine has been paid.

Therefore, the total fine is a fine of \$3,000.00 payable within 90 days or the license will be suspended until the fine has been paid.
